Daily report on the situation of Palestinian refugees in Syria



" The death of three Palestinians in Syria raises the toll of victims to 3629 refugees"

- Clashes between ISIS and the opposition groups on the outskirts of Yarmouk camp
- The Syrian regime continues to detain the Palestinian "Khalil Ibrahim Shakosh" since 2014



Latest Developments

"Magdy Gamal Ajaj," a resident of Al-Aedin camp in the city of Hama, has died while fighting alongside the Syrian regime forces, in the ongoing clashes in Al-Bukamal city located in the Deir ez-Zour governorate in east Syria.

The Palestinian man "Alaa Mohamed Zoubaa" from Jarmana camp in the suburbs of Damascus, also died while fighting alongside the Syrian regime forces, in the continuous clashes in Idlib, north of Syria. Is is from the Dawara village in Palestine.

The Palestinian Sheikh and Lawyer, "Fayez Diab Diab," died due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons. This brings the number of Palestinian victims of torture, documented by the Action Group, to 475.



In another context, the eastern outskirts of Yarmouk camp witnessed clashes between Jaish Al-Ababeel, one of the armed opposition factions, and ISIS. Our correspondent stated that the light and medium weapons were used in the fighting which occurred



on the axis of Daaboul Street and the Tuesday market, located on the outskirts of the Palestine roundabout.

Our reporter added that the fighting led to the death of a member of ISIS with a sniper shot, and the mild injury of one of the Jaish's members, according to what the latter posted on their Facebook page.

The area between Yarmouk camp and the town of Yelda is subjected to clashes from time to time, as ISIS attempts to progress at the expense of the opposition groups in the town of Yelda, south of Damascus.

In the meantime, the Syrian regime continues to detain the Palestinian man, "Khalil Ibrhaim Shakosh,"born in 1987, for the third consecutive year. The Syrian regime arrested him on 01-12-2014 from his home in Jdaydet Artooz, in the suburbs of Damascus, and took him to an unknown place. To this date, no information has been revealed about his location or fate.





AGPS receives a number of messages and information about the detained Palestinians. They are then documented despite the difficulty of recording information because the Syrian regime continues to hide the fate, names and locations of the detainees. The Group has recorded the detention of 1644 Palestinian refugees in the Syrian regime prisons, of which 106 are females.

Palestinians of Syria: December 31, 2017 Statistics:

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3631, including 463 women
- 1644 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 106
 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,628 days in a row
- 204 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1365 days, and 1205 days in Yarmouk Camp
- The Regime army has been in control of Handarat camp for more than 464 days. More than 80% of its buildings have been completely or partially destroyed.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
