#### **Victims**

The Palestinian Female refugee, Mayada Yousef Nouraj, died at the Turkish borders while travelling to Turkey in order to escape the hell of war in Syria.

Doctors reported that she died due to Myocardial infarction. She is in her thirties, a resident of the Yarmouk camp and was displaced to Khan Dannon Camp.



#### Recent Updates

Violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk refugee camp south of the Syrian capital Damascus between Palestinian armed groups and ISIS alongside Al-Nusra Front.

The clashed were focused in the court area and Rijayard, coincided with bombing with a number of RPGs that targeted the vicinity of sports city and resulted in only material damages.

Meanwhile, a number of Yarmouk besieged students exit yesterday in order to perform general information exam and return beck, where the National Commission inside the camp completed arrangements for that.

In Damascus Suburb, Syrian Warplanes targeted Khan Al Shieh camp with four explosive barrels, where two of them were exploded and led to a fear state amongst residents specially women and children, in addition to the houses destruction.

The Syrian Army targeted Zakia road with heavy guns, which is the only road connects the camp with the adjacent areas, coincided with violent clashes between the Syrian Army and the Opposition Armed groups.

Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road is considered the only lifeline for the camp with the cut of all roads, moreover, it is the most dangerous road where the residents are always exposed to targeting, and many victims died while they were crossing the death road. The AGPS documented 134 victims from the residents of Khan Al Shieh camp who died during the war in Syria.


Meanwhile, Jaramana camp residents live in a relative calm, which is 8 km far from Damascus the Syrian capital and located on the road to Damascus International Airport, however, its residents suffer of the unavailability of basic services and infrastructure, they also complain of the high costs of rent houses and the increased demand on those houses, which prompted the residents to live in severe circumstances due to the high rate of unemployment in the time of the decrease of the aid by the charity organizations and UNRWA.

It is noted that the camp suffers from the crowdedness due to the big wave of displacement to the camp from the Palestinian camps in Damascus.

In Homs, the Syrian Security arrested the Palestinian Youth Alaa Darwish on 28th of August 2015 at Al Aedin camp at Homs. The members of the Political Security branch arrested Alaa to an unknown area.

He is in the thirties, from Safad in Palestine. It is referred that the AGPS documented 178 detainees from Al Aedin camp in Homs whose destiny is still unknown. In a related context, the Syrian Security released three refugees from Al Nairab camp after days of detention by the Syrian

Security checkpoints, they are; Yasser Abdelraheem, Abdullah Sahtout and Abu Ali Rafi'. They are from Al Quds brigade that is affiliated to the Syrian regime and fight besides the Syrian Army. It is worthy to mention that these arrest actions came as entire disputes between the groups and committees that are affiliated to the Syrian Regime, according to some activists.



#### Lebanon

Fatah Movement at Ein Al Helwa camp south of Lebanon delivered the Palestinian Syrian refugee Ali Sh to the Lebanese Army Intelligence, under the pretext of participation in the latest clashes in the camp between Jond Al Sham and Fatah movement.

The AGPS correspondent inside the camp reported that the leadership of Fatah delivered him on the Army checkpoint at the entrance of the camp after he was accused of participation in the clashes besides Jond al Sham after the attempt to assassinate the head of the Palestinian National Security in Ein Al Helwa camp Sa'd Al Armoushi, which led hundreds of residents and Palestinian Syrian families to leave the camp fearing on their children's and their lives.

#### Numbers and Statistics till 31/8/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 790 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 860 days, water was cut for 350 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 652 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 853 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 497 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
