"Unexploded Missiles that Targeted Khan Al Shieh Camp Avoid Residents of a Potential Massacre"

Recent Updates

Warplanes targeted scattered areas at Khan Al Shieh Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb yesterday with a number of missiles. Some missiles did not explode which avoided the residents a potential massacre.



The warplanes also continued targeting the camp till night with a number of missiles and explosive barrels, which resulted in heavy explosions that rocked the camp.

Our correspondent reported that the Syrian Regime's warplanes dropped more than 12 explosive barrels on Sunday night. The barrels targeted the surrounding farms at Damascus western suburb, which resulted in a state of panic among the inhabitants especially the children.

The shelling targeted Al Abaseia area, Al Qusour area, and Al Salam highway, while artillery shelling targeted the eastern vicinity of the camp at Talat Al Mansoura area in Artouz and Talat Al Kabouseia.

He also noted that the Regular Army still targets the only road left for Kahn Al Shieh residents in the western suburb of Damascus with heavy machineguns, while activists and a number of residents warned from the risk of passing through this road where many residents died while passing through it.



Turning to Damascus; the Palestinian refugee, Ammar Rashied Rayyan, died after leaving the Yarmouk camp, which is besieged for more than 1112 consecutive days. The refugee left the camp heading to Jaffa hospital in Damascus in order to receive treatment after he suffered from severe fluid in heart and lungs. The death of Ammar raised the number of siege victims to 187 victims, who died due to starvation and lack of medical care, according to the AGPS documented statistics.

Meanwhile, residents of Al Aedein camp complain of the abusive practices of the Regular Army, who deliberately closed all exists and entrances of the camp except for the main entrance.

The Army also has put sand berms and concrete blocks between the camp and Al Shmas neighborhood, as it extends barbed wire between the camp and Al Sham Road in order to close all the roads leading to it. Meanwhile, the relevant authorities built and installed an iron fence separates neighborhoods of Al Aedein camp in Homs and the surrounding neighborhoods, which reflected negatively on living and economic conditions.



In Lebanon, the Palestinians of Syria Workers League held an honoring ceremony sponsored by the International Campaign to preserve the Palestinian identity. The ceremony was held in order to honor the Palestinians of Syria workers displaced in Lebanon on the occasion of the International Labor Day. The ceremony, which was held on Friday, April 29 / 2016 in the city of Sidon, southern Lebanon, included a number of words praised the occasion and the efforts of workers, in addition to their role in the construction process.



Civil Work Committees

The Palestinian Red Crescent Society in Homs- volunteer department- organized a campaign last Saturday, titled "Hand in hand to cleaner camp " to spray insecticides in Al Aedein camp in Homs. The campaign targeted most streets and alleys of the camp, so as to alleviate the large number of insects and to avoid the spread of diseases and epidemics.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 01\05\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*

- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1051 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1112 days, water was cut for 601 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 905 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1096 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 758 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
