"Syrian Security Arrests 6 Residents from Khan Al Sheih Camp and Tightens its Security Procedures at its Checkpoints"





Recent Updates

The Syrian security forces carried out an arrest campaign by a sudden checkpoint at the road of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb, as they arrested 6 residents on last Wednesday, they are:


"Ayman Mahmoud Al Mousa", 23 years, an employee at AL Kiswa labs, "Ahmed Sami", 32 years, a driver, "Moayad Mohammed Saed", 37 years, a government employee, "Fadi Yasein Taha", 28 years, "Mohammed SulaimanMousa", 27 years, a driver, while our correspondent pointed out that the 8th detainee couldn't be identified after his family refused to reveal his name for fear of his life, as they think. Our correspondent added that the checkpoint members released two residents after being detained for four hours, as "Samir Hasan Marzouq", 34 years, from Khan Al Sheih camp, was missed about two weeks ago and no information about him yet.

In the same context, artillery shells targeted the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp, while the explosion sounds were heard clearly inside the camp, which led to a state of anxious among the residents who are suffering of severe living crises due to the deteriorated security situation at the surrounding areas.

A resident of the camp reported news, to the AGPS, about a campaign of accurate searching of all passengers, cars, and busses, which are heading to the camp, and confiscated the food supplies they have, by the members of AL Mash'ham checkpoint of the regular army at Kawkab city. According to a passenger testimony, the checkpoint members searched the bread packs then they gave the owner of the pack only 8 loaves and confiscated the rest of the pack.

Meanwhile, warplanes carried out two raids at AL Hajar Al Aswad neighborhood adjacent to the besieged Yarmouk camp in Damascus, resulted in strong explosion sounds were heard clearly inside the camp. It is mentioned that about 20,000 residents still under strict siege imposed by the regular army and groups of PFGC for 545 days respectively, while they complain of the suspension of entering urgent food aids for about 4 weeks.

Meanwhile, the AGPS has documented the data of 158 Palestinian refugees who were killed till the end of 2014 due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the continuous siege.



Yarmouk camp

The residents of AL Nairab camp in Aleppo are complaining of the scarcity of fuel, especially the diesel that is needed to operate the generators, forcing many residents to stop operating their generators. It is mentioned that the repeated power cut forced some residents to sell the power through their generators.

On the other hand, pro-Fatah Movement at Al Nairab camp commemorated its 50th anniversary, as they gathered and raised the movement flags and photos of the late Palestinian president "Yasser Arafat" and lights a torch of the 50th anniversary.

It is mentioned that repeated clashes that broke out at Al Nairab camp, which is fully controlled by the regime forces, between the Syrian regular army and groups affiliated to the Syrian armed opposition during the last months.

Civil Work Committees

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 1/1/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- 2596 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS including 157 women, 283 were killed due to torture, 268 were killed by sniper shot, 84 refugees were field executed, and 984 refugees were killed due to bombing.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 545 days respectively. In addition, power cuts

continued for more than 625 days, water was cut for 115 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 158 victims.

- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November 2014.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 447 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 417 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 618 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 262 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL SaiedaZAinab, Al Raml, Al AedeinCamps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
