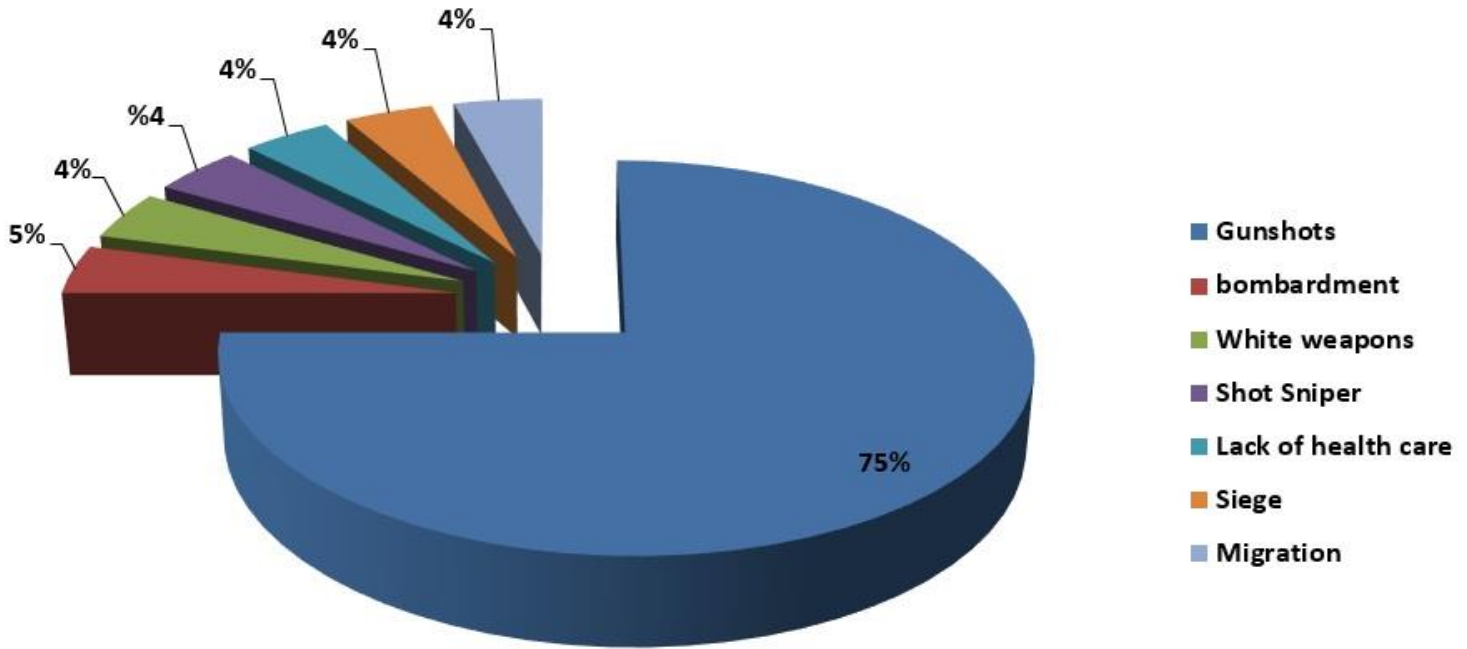

## "24 Palestinian-Syrians died during September 2017"

- Deraa camp and areas inhabited by Palestinian families in south Syria targeted
- Tension in Al-Qadam elevates and reports of a possible military operation
- Relief campaign launched for Palestinian refugees and the displaced from Syria to Lebanon

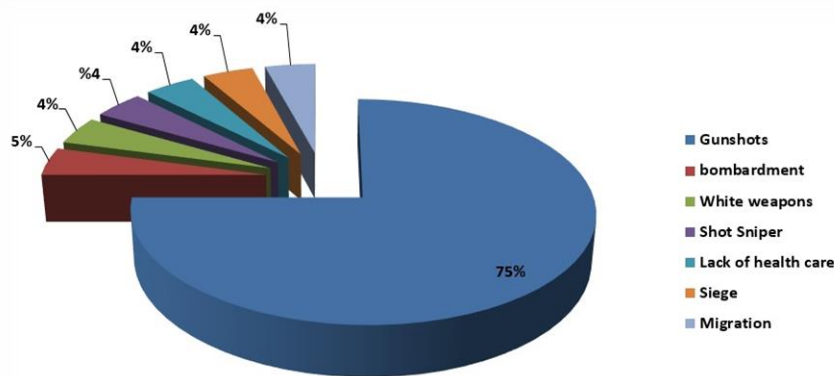

## Latest Developments

AGPS's Monitoring and Documentation Team has revealed that 24 Palestinian refugees died during September 2017, of which 18 died of gunshot wounds, one person due to shelling, one died of a white weapon wound, one refugee died of a sniper shot, two people died as a result of the siege and lack of medical care, while one person died during migration.



AGPS also revealed the Syrian areas in which the Palestinian victims died and they were as follows: 7 refugees died in Raqqa, 5 died in Al-Shoula area, 5 died in unknown locations, while 2 people died in Yarmouk camp, 2 others in Hama suburb, two people died in Yelda and one person died in Jobar.

In south Syria, civilian sources stated that Deraa camp was targeted with heavy machine guns belonging to the Syrian regime forces stationed at the new court checkpoint.

Near Deraa camp, Al-Mansheya neighborhood, in which dozens of Palestinian families live, was targeted by snipers from the regime forces, killing a civilian living in the neighborhood.

Al-Sad road was also targeted by the Syrian forces with mortar shells, yesterday. Houses were destroyed and a state of terror shook the residents. Meanwhile, residents of Deraa camp, which 80% of its buildings have been destroyed, as well as the Palestinian families living in Al-Sad road are complaining of the harsh living conditions due to the siege imposed by the Syrian regime forces on the camp and its neighboring areas. They are also suffering of a severe lack of food and electricity, water and communications cuts for long periods of time.

In a similar context, tension in Al-Qadam, Damascus, elevated and a state of fear took over the area's residents, after the Syrian forces warned residents living near the city's police station, city hall and the contact points with Al-Hajar Al-Aswad, which is controlled by ISIS, to leave their houses in anticipation for a military operation.



In another context, ISIS continues to dig tunnels and increase fortifications on the contact points with "Tahrir Al-Sham" and opposition factions in Yelda. ISIS had previously threatened Al-Qadam's residents of breaking into the area, in conjunction with a

state of alert in the areas under its control in Al-Hajar Al-Aswad and Al-Assaly neighborhood.

Under the slogan “Forgotten on the Winter Cusp,” Israa Charity Organization launched a new relief campaign in the Lebanese camps, for 5 days starting Monday October 2nd.

According to its organizers, the campaign aims to help the Palestinian refugees in Lebanon and the displaced Palestinian people from Syria and helping them through their difficult living conditions with winter coming in.

Food parcels and financial aid will be offered, as well as medical support to the severely ill, as well as inspecting people's conditions and listening to their urgent humanitarian situations and needs.

The organizers added that the campaign also attempts to highlight the suffering and needs of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon, amid the terrible conditions they are living and working on getting relief and humanitarian support to help the Palestinians in camps and gatherings in Lebanon.

## **Palestinians of Syria: October 1, 2017 Statistics:**

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3593, including 462 women
- 1639 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 105 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,537 days in a row
- 199 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1274 days, and 1114 days in Yarmouk Camp
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo have been banned from their homes for 1,610 days. Government troops have taken over the camp for more than 361 days.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
