Latest Developments

Displaced Palestinian families north of Syria rallied on October 31, protesting their tragic living conditions in the poorly-equipped Deir Ballout Camp.

The refugees urged UNRWA, the Palestine Liberation Organization, and the concerned NGOs to live up to their responsibilities as regards dozens of hopeless families taking shelter in Deir Ballout Camp and to provide them with muchneeded cash aids, medical items, and relief services.

Some 325 Palestinian families displaced from southern Damascus to the poorly-equipped Deir Ballout refugee camp, north of Syria, continue to launch cries for help over their exacerbated humanitarian situation.



The camp has been a hotbed for snakes and rodents. Civilians have also been subjected to an acute dearth in much-needed food and drinking water.

Children taking refuge in the camp have been unable to pursue their studies as no educational facilities have been established in



the area. The lack of healthcare facilities has made the situation far worse. Disease-stricken refugees are treated inside a poorlyequipped makeshift tent-clinic.

Along the same line, Palestinians taking shelter in AlMuzeireeb town expressed deep concern over the security situation in the area after reports have emerged on the assassination of Syrian national Yaser Yousef AlMusalmah, who was gunned down by anonymous gunmen on October 30.

Over recent years, several assassination attempts have targeted Palestinian refugees in the area.

AGPS documented the death of dozens of Palestinian refugees in AlMuzeireeb town, home to 1,700 Palestinian families displaced from Daraa Camp.

In another development, residents of AlMukhtar Abu Adnan neighborhood in AlSabina Camp for Palestinian refugees, in Rif Dimashq, continue to speak up against the trash mounds piled up across residential alleyways and access roads for over 10 consecutive days.





Speaking with AGPS, civilians said the municipality and other concerned authorities have turned deaf ears to their frequent appeals to clear garbage, saying the trash truck has not showed up in the area for over 10 days.

Located some 14 kilometers away from southern Damascus, AlSabina Camp has been gripped with an abject situation owing to the absence of humanitarian assistance, relief aids, proper infrastructure, and vital facilities. Frequent water and power outages have made the situation far worse.

In the meantime, Palestinian young man Mahmoud Hanino, from AlNeirab Camp in Aleppo, has been enduring a mysterious fate in Syrian state prisons, where he has been locked up since 2015.

AGPS has documented the secret incarceration of 1,768 Palestinian refugees in Syrian government dungeons, among them 108 women and girls.
