Victims

Three Palestinians died due to shelling and clashes in the Yarmouk camp. They are:

The media activist "Jamal Khalifa" died while covering the battles in the Yarmouk camp after being injured with shrapnel. The young man "Abdulateif AL Rimawi" died due to the shelling that targeted the Yarmouk camp. The two young men Khalifa and AL Rimawi were buried at the garden of Abdulqader Al Hussenei mosque for not being able to reach the cemetery due to the violent clashes.

The refugee "Mohammed Khair Tameim" also died by a ISIS sniper in the Yarmouk camp.

Recent Updates

Violent battles by Aknaf Bait Al Maqdes Brigades yesterday after ISIS groups tried to break into the camp and terrorize the people, the battles began yesterday afternoon and was facilitated by Al Nusra Front which was claims that itwas dispute with "ISIS." Activists reported that Al

Nusra Front has handed over its areas to ISIS without any clashes; those areas formed the basis for ISIS to attack the rest of the Yarmouk areas.

ISIS broke into the camp in conjunction with the heavy shelling targeted different areas of the camp at Al KhamastaashStreet where ISIS controls one of the main headquarters of Al Nusra Front, and then control over large areas of Al Khamastaash Street and some areas around it in addition to the vicinity of Palestine mosque.

Aknaf Bait Al Maqdes brigades were mobilized and forced ISIS groups to retreat and centere in the areas controlled by Al Nusra Front; the area around Palestine mosque and some areas near Al KhamastaashStreet.

For its part, Al Nusra Front has put many checkpoints in the vicinity of the Palestine square so as to prevent the arrival of any supplies to the camp by the opposition factions in the adjacent town of Yelda.

During the frequent clashes, Palestine hospital was bombed with a number of shells, wounding a number of cadres, and states that the hospital, which was shelled, is the only hospital left for the people of the camp, where the siege imposed by the regular army and PFGC groups has led to the stop of all hospitals and clinics.

Activists stated to the AGPS that the source of the bombing was from the

areas controlled both ISIS in Al Hajar Al Aswad area and the regime at the entrances of the Yarmouk refugee camp.

Meanwhile, ISIS groups besieged Palestine Mosque, one of the key points that provide camp residents with drinking water, after the regime cut it for more than two hundred days, and in a similar act ISIS preventd roaming in the area, causing depriving people of drinking water.

At night, clashes renewed between Aknaf Bait Al Maqdes and ISIS in more than point, including the vicinity of electricity Company near Al KhamastaashStreet and the area around Palestinemosque.

In the meantime, groups of ISIS broke into a media headquarters inside the camp and looted its contents in an attempt to prevent the arrival of what is going on inside the camp to the media outside.

On the other hand, a number of Palestinian activists who are in Syria, Palestine, Lebanon, Turkey and the European Union launched a solidarity campaign with their relatives in Yarmouk, through the Hashtag "Yarmouk Will Not Fall" in an attempt to support their relatives inside the camp and expose ISIS acts and its support by Al Nusra Front groups.

On a different topic, the AGPS called the Syrian regime to disclose the status of hundreds of Palestinian detainees who is unaccounted for, stressing that what is happening inside the Syrian prisons for the Palestinians, "a war crime by any standard."

The AGPS issued numerous reports, including the report of "enforced disappearances 1," "enforced disappearances2," and "The Photos Massacre." The reports addressed the victims of Palestinian refugees

who were killed as a result of torture and enforced disappearances in the context of the bloody conflict between the Syrian regime and the opposition. The group confirmed that during the follow-up and monitoring the daily conditions of Palestinian refugees and documented information, that there are (379) Palestinian victims have been documented, including 59 Palestinian refugees have been identified through the leaked images of the victims of torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, (34) woman died due to torture, according to the testimony of one of the releaseddetainees, and others dozens of Palestinians and Syrians who have died in Syrian prisons as a result of direct assassination or under torture after being subjected to the harshest and most kinds of torture.

It has been monitoring a direct arrests against people at checkpoints or during raids carried out by the army inside the Syrian cities and villages, or during indiscriminate arrests, and after the arrest any point could not recognize the fate of the arrested person, and in numerous cases the security services connect the detainees relatives to receive the body from a military government or public hospitals.

Civil Work Committees

Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey finished distributing its relief aid to the Palestinian Syrian families in Kilis city in Turkey. The aid included food and blankets in addition to some candies for the children in the shelter center.

It is mentioned that thousands of Palestinians escaped from Syria to Turkey due to the shelling and the ongoing conflict. Unofficial statistics indicate that the number of the Palestinian Syrians in Turkey ranged between 3000-5000 refugees.

Numbers and Statistics till 1/4/2015:-

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 634 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 714 days, water was cut for 204 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 173 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.

- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 535 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 505 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 707 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 351 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
