Victims

The AGPS documentation and monitoring team announced that 38 Palestinian refugees died during May 2015, including 15 refugees died by gun shot, 10 refugees died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, 6 refugees died due to shelling, 1 refugee died due to siege and lack of medical care, 3 refugees died due to unknown reasons, 1 refugee died by snipers shot, 1 refugee died due to explosions, and a refugee was killed after being kidnapped.

Meanwhile, the AGPS indicated that the Palestinian refugees who died during last May were distributed to the Syrian cities as following: 14 victims in Damascus, 9 victims in Damascus suburb, 3 victims in Aleppo, 1 victim in Daraa, and 11 victims in different areas.

Recent Updates

A number of mortar shells targeted the houses of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb with no injuries. Two missiles targeted the camp's main water reservoir, while another missile targeted a resident's house at Al Hara Al Gharbeia which resulted in only material damages. Moreover, artillery shelling targeted different areas adjacent to Daraa camp south of Syria.

Moreover, shelling and explosive barrels target Daraa camp almost daily as a result of the intensified fighting at Daraa city and the neighboring areas, which resulted in massive destruction in most of houses and lanes of the camp. In terms of living aspect, the residents are suffering of

stifling living and humanitarian crises at various levels. Meanwhile, the camp lacks to fuel, bread, and life essentials in light of the high rate of unemployment after most of residents stopped working, and the urgent relief convoys stopped arriving to the camp due to the deteriorated security situation in Daraa governorate.

The high school students of Nairab camp started performing their exams the day before yesterday in Aleppo amid state of anxious for fear of families at their sons due to the tension security situation in Aleppo city, as it witnessed fall of shells by the armed opposition groups at the areas that controlled by the Syrian regime.

In the same context, high school students came out of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb in order to perform their exams in Al Kiswa town after providing them with buses for transportations. Meanwhile, lots of students did not manage to resume their education for being prosecuted by the Syrian Security forces in order to perform the obligatory military service, or for being wanted.

Detainees

Three years have passed after Dr. Hayel Qasim Hmaid was arrested by the Syrian security forces, while he was arrested from his clinic in the Yarmouk camp on 13-8-2012 in charges of curing the injured people who were wounded by shelling at Yarmouk and no news about him yet or the place where he is detained. It was mentioned that Dr. Hmaid, 66 years, was born on 1948 in Dalata area in Palestine; he is a Professor at the Faculty of Medicine - University of Damascus, and he also served as Head of general surgery department at the University hospital (Assad).

Turkey

During his participation in the march of Jerusalem that was launched the day before yesterday from Al Fateh Mosque in Istanbul to commemorate the martyrs of Marmara flotilla, Head of the Turkish Humanitarian Relief Body and Human Rights and Freedoms (IHH) "Bulent Yildirim," expressed surprise at the Turkish government who required visas for Palestinians into its territory, while Turkey does not impose such visas to Zionists

It is noteworthy that the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees, who fled to Turkey to escape the war, is ranging between 3000-5000 Palestinian refugees; most of them entered Turkey in informal ways, due to their inability to obtain regular visas to Turkish territory.

On the other hand, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey in cooperation with the Palestine Scholars distributed financial aid to Palestinian families displaced from Syria who reside in the Turkish city of Kilis, and visited some houses to check their living conditions and suffering.

Lebanon

Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon, Monitoring Committee for Palestinian Refugees from Syria to Lebanon, and some civil society institutions in Sidon and the camps met with director of "UNRWA" office in the Sidon area, Dr. Ibrahim al-Khatib, and Director of Ain al-Hilweh office, Mr. Fadi Salehin the agency's office in Sidon.

The meeting came in the framework of following-up UNRWA's services reduction and humanitarian impacts on Palestinian refugees in general and refugees of Lebanon and the Palestinians of Syria in particular. Meanwhile, the civil institutions demanded during the meeting, an urgent meeting with the Director General of UNRWA in Lebanon Mr. Mathias Schemale, in order to discuss recent UNRWA resolutions and its negative consequences on Palestinian refugees.

Numbers and Statistics till 1/6/2015

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.
- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 869 detainees, and 391 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 704 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 774 days, water was cut for 264 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 585 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 566 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 768 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 411 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.

- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
