"(43) Palestinians were killed in Syria in September 2016"



- A bombardment on Daraa leaves number of injuries and kills one Palestinian child.
- The targeting of an ambulance kills a medic from Khan Al-Sheih camp.
- Khan Al-Sheih and its outskirt were being shelled by phosphorous bombs and explosive barrels.
- Syrian security releases a Palestinian student after 10 days of arrest.
- Belgium donates with EUR 7 million to support UNRWA programs.

Statistics

AGPS documentation and observation team announced that (43) Palestinian refugees were killed in September 2016. In more details, (28) of them were shot, (9) were killed because of bombardments, (3) were tortured till death, (1) was killed because of snipping, (1) was killed because of Siege and lack of medical care and the last one was kidnapped and killed.

And according to their place of death, (19) refugees were killed in Damascus countryside, (8) refugees in Dier ez-Zor, (5) in Damascus, (3) in Daraa, (2) in Aleppo, (1) in Latakia, (1) in Quneirta and (9) in different places.

According documented statistics for AGPS, the number of Palestinian refugees, who were killed during the ongoing war in Syria have reached (3357) victims.





Victims

The Palestinian child "Nasem Qwaider" was killed in a bombing targeted Daraa while "Mohammed Ali" a Palestinian medic was also killed after the Syrian regime have targeted his ambulance.

Recent Updates

Syrian regime forces targeted Daraa camp the day before yesterday. As a result, "Nasem Qwaider" a Palestinian child was killed, a number of injuries some of them were serious, destruction in properties and panic among citizens. AGPS reporter had mentioned in a previous time that there isn't any hospital or medical center in the camp in addition to the severe lack of medicine, medical equipment to give first aid and ambulances to transfer injured people outside the camp to be treated. Some activists have warned from diseases which endangers citizens' lives especially that they drink polluted water.



Turning to western Damascus countryside, AGPS reporter stated that an ambulance lifting a number of injuries was bombed in the western side of



the camp and that led to the death of the Palestinian medic "Mohammed Ali". Moreover, Syrian regime aircrafts' dropped more than 16 explosive barrels targeting the farms of Khan Al-Sheih, Alderkhbayh and the valley in Almquilibh. Russian aircrafts shelled the camp's outskirts with the internationally prohibited phosphorous bombs. While Syrian forces targeted Khan Al- Sheih- Zakia road with bullets and artillery shells.



Syrian security releases the Palestinian -Syrian student " Rawand Abo Al Souod" (20) years old from Al Muzeireeb after 10 days of unjustified arrest. On the other hand," Yasmineen Maritah " (20) years and "Aaeda Awad" (30) years from Al Muzeireeb still under arrest for nearly a year. It's worth noting that AGPS documented the arrest of 22 Palestinians from Al Muzeireeb in Syrian regime prisons with anonymous fate. In addition to more than thousand similar Palestinian refugees.

In other context, Kingdom of Belgium has contributed with EUR 7 million euro supporting UNRWA efforts' in providing the Palestinian refugees with their educational and residential needs in the near East.



The pioneer UNRWA program for education in emergencies will be funded by EUR 5 million out of 7 million. The project aims to help 314,900 Palestinian refugee children in Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Gaza and West Bank till the first mid of 2018. It contains entertaining and educational safe spaces, interactive self-learning subjects, motivating activities to learn and safety training.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 2/10/2016

- *(15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.*
- *(42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *(6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.*
- *(8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.*
- *(1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.*
- *More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.*
- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1202) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1263) days. water was cut for (753) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1055) days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1247) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (905) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
