





Statistics

Monitoring and Documentation Team of AGPS has announced that (10) Palestinian Syrian refugees had died during the last month (November 2015) as follows: three refugees died because of gunshots, four refugees under torture in the Syrian Regime's prisons, one refugee due to shelling and clashes, one refugee due to unknown reasons, and lastly, one refugee because of the lack of medical care in the besieged Yarmouk Camp.



The AGPS statistics pointed out that the victims who died during November belong to different Syrian cities as follows:

Damascus: 2 refugees.

Damascus Suburb: 2 refugees.

Aleppo: 1 refugee.

Other cities: 5 refugees.

It is noteworthy that the amount to Palestinian Syrian refugees who died during the current conflict are (3070) victims according to the AGPS statistics.

Recent update

Syrian Regime's Anti-Aircraft weapons targeted the houses of civilians in Khan Eshieh Camp in Damascus Suburb, at the same time; the western sides of the camp were hit with many shells and mortars which caused no more than material damages.

It should be noted that this camp is being hit almost every day with explosive barrels and shells which led to many victims and injuries among the camp's people.

In a different context, the Syrian Security has released the Palestinian

Syrian Refugee "Yousuf Hasan Musleh" nicknamed "Abu Michelle" after being arrested for 10 months, "Yousuf" who lives in Khan Eshieh Camp in Damascus Suburb, left behind more than 1013 other Palestinian Syrian arrestees and 106 others descend from the same camp.



It is important to say that people of Khan Eshieh Camp in general are being targeted and exposed to arrest on most of the Regime's checkpoints, especially in Sahnaya and Jdaydit Artouz and Koukab nearby towns, where the Security Forces tend to put more strains and restrictions on civilians who try to pass back and forth. At the same time, the Syrian Regime keeps hiding any information about detainee's destiny.

In the middle of Syria, The migration of Al-Aidien Camp's people is still occurring where migrants head towards Europe though Turkey because of the worsening situations inside Syria. It has been noticed that a large

number of people have already left the camp towards Turkey in a bid to arrive Europe where they can ask for asylum and protection; meanwhile, many of them are still stuck in Turkey until now.

The reasons behind this increasing phenomenon are mainly the security persecution of the Regime's forces and other militias which arrest young men and lead them to the compulsory military service, this put more restrictions on people's movements and daily life.

Also, the repetitive arrests at Regime's checkpoints have turned the camp into a big prison most people afraid to leave, in addition to the hard living circumstances and high prices accompanied with lack of job chances and financial sources in general.

This coincides with the arrival of 7 refugees recently to Greece after long wait and unstable weather that put them under serious dangers, while tens or hundreds of other refugees still waiting for the suitable time to ride the sea.

Civil committees

"World Relief Committee" in cooperation with the "Charity Association to Relief the Palestinian People" start renovation works in the "Zaher Bin Haram" mosque in Al-Husayniyya Camp, this mosque is the second mosque to be renovated in this camp after "Khalil Al-Rahman" Mosque which had been reopened two weeks ago.

It is noteworthy that the renovation and the infrastructure rehabilitation works are expected to encourage people to return back to their homes

inside the camp and reopen stores and shops in spite of some harassment by the Syrian Security checkpoint at the Camp's Entrance which arrested many refugees recently, and imposed extortions on others.




Moving to the south of Syria, the "Palestine Charity Association" has distributed olive dreg to to be used as heating fuel to 400 displaced families in some towns to south of Syria (Mzierieb, Jillin, Jillin Ajami Housing, Tsiel, AinZakar), this material, which consists of the grinded seeds and leaves and any other remains of olives after being squeezed, is considered to be one the affordable quick-flammable materials which can be used easily in firewood stoves or fireplaces which became quite common in Syria due to the lack of fuel.

In Lebanon, Alwafaa European Campaign has distributed financial aid to 50 displaced families from Syria to Nahr Al-Bared and Al-Baddawi Camps in north of Lebanon where campaign members were yesterday, members visited the neediest families at their houses to have a close look on their living conditions.

In the meantime, the "Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon" in coordination with "Al-Shifaa Medical Society" has organized a free

medication day for children and displaced families to help them alleviate the economic burdens.

It is noteworthy that there are about (850) displaced families live in Al-Baddawi Camp out of (45,000) refugees fled Syria to Lebanon.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics till 2 December 2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFGC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 884 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 954 days, water cut for 444 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 745days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 946days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Water cut continues for 590 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
- Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Homs and AedeinHamma: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
