



"50 Palestinian Refugees Died During Last August in Syria"



- A Resident of the Yarmouk Camp Dies Due to Wounds in Clashes at Ain al-Hilweh Camp a Few Days Ago



Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team announced that "50" Palestinian refugees died during last August, including "11" refugees died due to gunshot, "6" refugees died under torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, while (17) refugees died as a result of shelling and clashes, "8" refugees drowned, two refugees died because of the siege and the lack of medical care, two refugees were executed in the field, one refugee died by a sniper, while (4) refugees died due to various reasons.

The AGPS pointed out that the Palestinian victims who died during last August dispersed by Syrian cities as follows: 6 refugees in Damascus, 10 refugees in Damascus suburb, 12 refugees in Daraa, 2 refugees in the Lebanese city of Sidon, one refugee in Swaidaa, one refugee in Idlib, and 17 refugees were killed in scattered areas.

The number of Palestinian refugees who were killed during war in Syria amounted to "3001" refugees, according to documented statistics by the AGPS.

Victims

The Palestinian Syrian refugee Mazin Muneer Saleh died due to wounds he attained during clashes at Ein Al-Hilweh camp in Lebanon several days ago between Fatah and Jund Alsham. Mr. Saleh was transferred to Labib medical center in the city of Sidon south Lebanon in order to receive treatment, while he was displaced with his wife from Yarmouk to Ein Al-Hilweh camp in Lebanon.

Recent Updates

A number of mortar shells targeted Muzeireeb town southern Syria, which inhabited with about 8,500 Palestinian refugees. The shelling resulted in destruction in civilian homes.

Meanwhile, the state of tension till prevails in the southern region of Syria because of bombing with rockets and explosive barrels since the factions in the southern front of the Syrian armed opposition announced the launch of south storm battle on June 25, in order to control the areas

that are still under the control of government forces in the province of Daraa.

In a different context, media sources close to the Syrian regime said that reconciliation was reached in the town of Qudsaya in Damascus suburb between people of the town and the competent authorities in the Syrian authority, where it was agreed to end the armed manifestations and the return of safety and security to the region.

Accordingly, small amounts of flour, vegetables, and gas entered to the town, pending the road to be open and the life to return to normal later.

It should be noted that the town of Qudsaya inhabited with approximately 6,000 Palestinian families displaced from the Palestinian refugee camps, most of them from Yarmouk, while the regular army has imposed a siege on the region on 23 July, because of the kidnapping of one of its members by groups of the armed opposition.

In Damascus suburb, a state of relative calmness prevailed Alsayeda Zainab camp which receives a number of displaced families from other camps such as Yarmouk and Hosseinieh camps.

According to a resident testimony, war events in Syria came to a large part of the camp houses, while large number of its residents died, who are estimated by reports with 100 victims and 200 injured between amputation and permanent impairments.

The AGPS documentation team documented the names of 42 victims from Sayeda Zeinab camp died since the beginning of war in Syria, as well as they also documented the names of 32 detainees at the Syrian security services.

Turning to the center of Syria, Syrian security forces released the Palestinian young man Walid Zakaria Khalil al-Halabi from Al Aedein camp in Homs. He was released two days ago after being detained for 22 days for the similarity in names; he is in his thirties and originally from Acre city in Palestine.

On the other hand, the Syrian security services continue to detain ten Palestinian refugees from one family since 12-6-2013; They are: Mahira Mohammed Amayri, HAdeel Mahmoud Amayri, Aseel Mahmoud Amayri, Widad Mahmoud Amayri, Razan Mahmoud Amayri, Suhair Mohammed Amayri, Maysa Jamal Idris, Firas Walid Desouki, and his children Hamza Firas Desouki and Hala Firas Desouki, where they was arrested by members of Nasreen Street checkpoint at Al Tadamon neighborhood of the Syrian army regulars.






In the meantime, the Slovak authorities continue to arrest all of Basil and Khaled Shankal, another refugee from Ghadhban family, and two families from the Yarmouk refugee camp in its jails on charges of entering the country in an irregular manner since July 1, 2015.

Meanwhile, on August 25, 2015 those authorities released the Palestinian refugee "Fadi Kassim" and his family.

The refugees had fled from their camps in Syria and then rode "boats of death" to Greece and then crossed into Hungary which forced them to forcibly fingerprint, then tried to go to Germany but they were arrested by the Slovak authorities on its territory.

Numbers and Statistics till 2/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 792 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 862 days, water was cut for 352 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 654 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 855 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 499 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
