#### Latest Developments

ISIS militias, who have seized large areas of Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus, executed four refugees, sources in the camp told AGPS.

The four casualties are identified as Mohamed Nassar and a refugee from Alyan family, along with another from AlTayeha family and two more refugees from Tahrir AlSham battalion. The security turmoil in the camp prevented AGPS correspondent from identifying the four names. Efforts have been underway by the group to reveal the victims' identities.



At the same time, AGPS quoted activists as stating that ISIS in southern Damascus issued orders to execute whoever is caught raising the Palestinian flag in ISIS-controlled zones.

In 2016, ISIS disfigured the pictures of former Palestinian President Yasser Arafat in Yarmouk Camp.

ISIS mobs held sway over the camp in April 2015, in cooperation with AlNusra Front.

Meanwhile, Palestinian youth Badr Walid Faris sustained wounds as he took part in pro-government battles in Eastern AlGhouta, in Rural Damascus.

Since the outburst of the Syrian warfare, hundreds of Palestinian refugees have been lured to join pro-regime squads, having no other sources of income to feed their starved families.

In a related development, AGPS news correspondent in Rif Dimashq (Rural Damascus) said the Palestinian refugee Shadi Ibrahim Youssef, nicknamed Shadi AlMukhtar, was released from a Syrian government lock-up.

Shadi, a resident of Khan AlSheih Camp, was kidnapped at the Darousha checkpoint last month on his way back to Khan AlSheih.

Syrian national Shadi AlKhatib, taking shelter in Khan AlSheih Camp, was also released from a government detention center, a few days after he was kidnapped from his workplace.

125 Palestinian residents of Khan AlSheih Camp have been held in Syrian government penitentiaries, among a total of 1,169 Palestinian detainees, whose fate has been shrouded in mystery in Syrian penitentiaries.

In another development, Palestinian refugees from Syria who have been stranded in Greece have sounded distress signals after most European states opted for a closed-door immigration policy, leaving hundreds of refugees trapped in underequipped makeshift refugee camps in Greece.

Speaking with AGPS, Palestinian refugees in Greece said they have been subjected to medical neglect, poor hygiene, and over-crowdedness, along with the lack of relief assistance and the propagation of poisonous reptiles in the frayed tents they have been locked up in.

An agreement between Turkey and Greece to tighten grip on refugees from Syria trying to creep into the Greek territories via the Turkish borders has made the situation far worse.



#### Palestinians of Syria: March 3, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,453 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,169 Palestinian refugees, including 83 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,352 days in a row.

- 190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,056 and 864 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,400 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 134 days.
- Government troops ban residents of AlSbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,205 days running.
- Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
