



VICTIMS

The Palestinian refugee "Ibrahim Mahmoud Mohammed" from Al-Yarmouk camp has been tortured to death in regime's prisons. He was announced dead by his family yesterday after being detained for more than three years.

The AGPS has documented a total of 438 Palestinians died due to torture in prisons over the course of the war in Syria.

The Palestinian boy "Mohammad Abdulaal Abu Saleh" from Daraa camp killed by a gunshot of one of the regime's snipers positioned around the area.

This incident brings the total number of sniped children since the beginning of war to 15 according to the AGPS' statistics.




RECENT UPDATES

The monitoring and documentation team of the AGPS announced, this morning, that the total victims of Palestinian refugees killed in Syria during the last month of March is 10. 4 by gunshots, 2 tortured to death in prisons, 2 by shelling, 1 by bombardment, and 1 by sniper shot.

Those victims were documented all over the Syrian provinces as following: 4 in Damascus Countryside, 3 in Aleppo, 1 in Latakia, and 2 in unspecified places.

In Lebanon, the tragedy of around 870 families displaced from Syria emerged again after clashes broke out recently in Ein-Elhilweh camp in Lebanon.

The clashes already caused death to one and few were injured, in addition to causing fears and chaos state inside the camp which pushed many of PRS families to flee and seek safe shelters in other places such as the nearby Sidon City, according to field sources.

As a reminder, a significant decrease in numbers of PRS families in Ein-Elhilweh had been noted over the course of the last two years. The number dropped from 2500 in 2014 to 1400 in 2015, while the latest census in 2016 revealed that only 870 families are remaining inside the camp.

This drop comes as a result of the tense situation and security deterioration in the camp every now and then, which pushed the majority of PRS families to leave and seek asylum in Europe, while some of them who were not able to arrive in Europe had no choice but to risk their lives and return back to Syria.

Palestinians from Syria in numbers and statistics Until 3 April 2016

- 15,000 Palestinian refugee from Syria in Jordan,
- 6,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics of July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian refugee from Syria arrived Europe by the end of December 2015.
- Al-Yarmouk Camp: still under the siege imposed by Syrian Regime's Army and the PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command for 1023 days. Power cut for 1084 days, water cut for 573 days. The number of victims resulting from the siege is 186.
- Al-Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning to their houses for 879 days.

- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1071 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: water cut continues for 732 days. 70% of its buildings are destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-Aedein camp of Hama: A relatively quiet situation with economic crises.
- Khan Eshieh Camp: All roads linking the camp to the city are still closed back and forth except for Zakia-Khan Eshieh road.
