Latest Developments

The Syrian government forces struck Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees south of Syria with three ground-to-ground missiles, a couple of days after the camp was hit with barrel bombs. The offensives resulted in heavy material damage.

The regime troops further targeted AlSadd Road, housing Palestinian families in Daraa, with home-made surface-to-surface missiles. Mortar shells also slammed into Nasib town, in Daraa's eastern outskirts.



In the meantime, the government forces have reportedly intensified presence on the outskirts of Daraa Camp in an attempt to break into the area.

Meanwhile, a fighter from Tahrir AlSham Commission (formerly known as AlNusra Front) and his family were allowed access into Idlib through government checkpoints. The retreat, carried out under the supervision of the Syrian Red Crescent, was made in exchange for the safe withdrawal of four wounded people, along with their 12 family members, from Kafria and AlFoua to Aleppo.

The retreat of all Tahrir AlSham fighters from Yarmouk Camp and AlKadam is expected to be finalized in the next few days, according to government affiliates and reports leaked by Tahrir AlSham allies.



Overnight on Saturday, reports emerged on the intent of the government troops to creep into southern Damascus, mostly into areas led by the opposition.

Activists spoke out against the state of unrest sparked by such rumors which they said might be used as pretexts for mass deportation, as was the case with Yarmouk residents.

Palestinians of Syria: June 3, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,506 Palestinians, including 462 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,603 Palestinian refugees, including 99 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.

- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,412 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,147 and 998 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,491 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 225 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
