"3 Palestinian Refugees Killed in Syria's Raging Warfare"

Latest Developments

Three Palestinian refugees died as they fought alongside the pro-government Liwa AlQuds battalion in clashes with ISIS in AlSalmiya area, in Hama's eastern suburbs.

The casualties are: Abdullah Khalil AlRifi, a third year student of English literature; Amjad Zuhair Abd Rabbo, and Ahmed Ghayath Daoud. They are residents of AlNeirab refugee camp.

AGPS documented the death of 54 Palestinians from AlNeirab Camp in clashes rocking war-ravaged Aleppo.



Meanwhile, a bomb exploded in a civilian car in AlMzeirib town, south of Syria, after it was planted by anonymous gunmen. No casualties were reported in the blast.

Tension has been running high in AlMzeirib due to the security mayhem rocking the area. Deadly blasts hitting AlMzeirib have claimed the lives of dozens of civilians.

Activists held the Syrian government responsible for the security turmoil, assassinations, and blasts in opposition-led zones in war-torn Syria.



Others pointed the finger at foreign parties involved in hostilities in southern Syria. Other activists attributed the situation to the internal rifts among the opposition outfits in the area.

AGPS kept record of the death of 379 Palestinian victims from Daraa province. AlMzeireeb town, Daraa, is home to 1,700 Palestinian families along with hundreds of other Palestinian families displaced from Daraa Camp.



In the meantime, AGPS documented the death of 1,868 Palestinians in refugee camps and communities across the Syrian territories.

Yarmouk Camp, in Damascus, topped the list with 1,064 casualties, followed by 213 from Daraa Camp, 139 from Khan AlSheih Camp, 54 from AlNeirab Camp, 94 from AlHusseiniya Camp, 86 from AlSayeda Zeinab Camp, and 50 others from AlSebina Camp.

46 refugees from Handarat Camp, 32 from AlMzeirib town, 27 from Jaramana Camp, 22 from Hums-based AlAydeen Camp, and 20 from Hama-based AlAydeen Camp were also pronounced dead in the rampant hostilities.



AGPS noted the death of 10 Palestinian refugees from Khan Dannun Camp, seven from AlRaml Camp, in Latakia, and six others in AlDhiabiya, in Rif Dimashq. One more refugee died in Ruk Aldin, in Damascus.

In another development, five years have passed by since AlJa'ouna massacre, perpetrated on August 2, 2012, claimed the lives of over 20 Palestinians in Yarmouk Camp, south of Damascus, among them children. Several other Palestinians were left wounded after two mortar shells slammed into the area prior to iftar (fast-breaking) time.

The list of casualties included the two children Anas Talouzi and Ibrahim Talouzi, along with Yahya Alyan, Fathi Alyan, Alaa Ghneim, Mohamed Anbatawi, aged 42, Rafe' AlRefa'i, Abdullah Saleh, aged 13, Mohamed Msheinessh, Ahmed Areisha, Mohamed Rafe' Ali AlRefa'i, aged 27, Wael Adnan Atiyeh AlAhmed, Bahaa Ayoub, aged 21, Mahmoud Qanah, Alaa Mohamed Ghneim, Muhssin Walid Msheinessh, Osama Akram Areisha, Yahya Ismail Alyan, Khairou Ahmed Hamida, and Emad Salah Aldin Qadah.





Palestinians of Syria: August 03, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,547 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,621 Palestinian refugees, including 102 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,469 days in a row.*
- *196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,208 and 1,057 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,551 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 304 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria fled to Europe until the end of 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
