

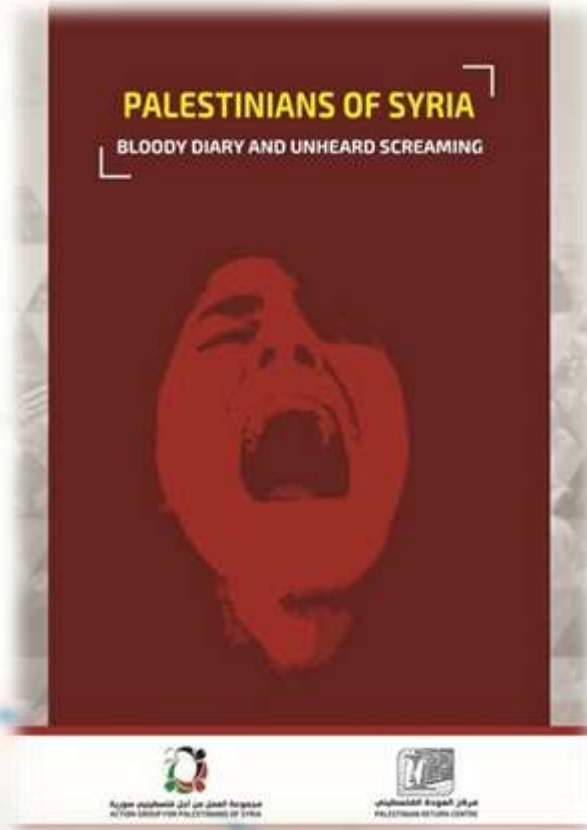

“AGPS and PRC Issued the English Version of the Documentary Report for Palestinians of Syria Situation during the First Half of 2015”

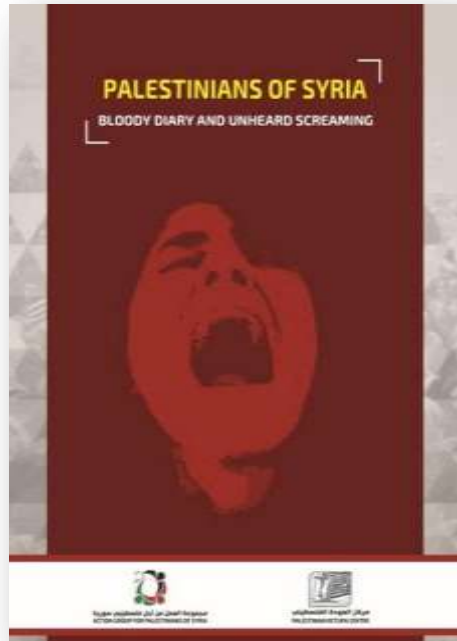

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria “AGPS”

Under the Title “Palestinians of Syria, Bloody Diary and Unheard Screaming” AGPS issued in cooperation with the Palestine Return Center in London “PRC” the English Electronic Issue from the Documentary Report for Palestinians of Syria Refugees from January 2015 to June 2015.



The report discussed the tragedy of the Palestinians of Syria through five axes that were distributed to 133 pages. The first and second axes discussed the situation in the Palestinian camps and compounds in Syria and the suffering of its residents from the scourge of the war during the first six months of 2015. The third axis shed light on the Syrian Palestinian victims who died during the first half of 2015. They are about 303 victims during that period, out of 2910 Palestinian Syrian



Refugee victims who died until the end of June 2015, according to Statistics of the Action Group.

In addition, this axis included statistics for the Palestinian Syrian victims classified by date, place, and cause of death and the axis also contained a detailed list of torture victims who were identified through the leaked images from the Syrian prisons or through the released eye witnesses, who are recognized about 78 victims. The fourth axis discussed the situation of the displaced Palestinians of Syria to Lebanon, Turkey, and Europe, as well as the living and legal problems they face in these countries.

The fifth axis was specialized to address migration issues, methods, risks, and the problems facing the Palestinians of Syria refugees during their search for safety. It is noteworthy that the report was based on monitoring and following-up operations condemned by AGPS through a network of field correspondents and a group of researchers and those interested in the Palestinian issue to document an important stage of the Palestinian refugees and to prepare for necessary documents for the defense of refugees in the local, regional and international forums.

It is worth mentioning that AGPS and the Palestinian Return Centre in London "PRC" had issued three similar documented reports during the previous years. The first report was about the situation of Palestinians of Syria released in 2014, while the two other reports were issued to document the suffering of Palestinians in Syria during (2014), with the title "The Wound of the Syrian Palestinians is still bleeding" and "Palestinians of Syria between the hope of Return and the Bitterness of Reality".

Recent Updates

Heavy explosions rocked Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb that caused panic and tension state amongst the residents due to targeting the parts of the camp and the adjacent farms and areas with two explosive barrels by the Warplanes. The camp's residents suffer from big crises in transportation due to closing all roads connecting the camp with the capital center because of the frequent bombing in the area. The necessity forced the people to go through Zakia-khan Al Sheih road despite its danger where many cars were targeted during the last months.

In terms of living, the markets of the camp witness the loss of a number of basic items and high prices of the available items. It is referred that the Syrian Army targeted Sharaf Street at the beginning of Khan Al Sheih camp with a land rocket which only led to material damages.



In a separate context, the adjacent neighborhoods of Jaramana camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb were targeted with a number of shells that were heard clearly inside the camp. It is referred that Jaramana camp is considered a relatively calm camp compared to other camps, however, the displaced residents inside the camp suffer of bad economic situations due to the spread of unemployment, the high cost of living, and the high rents of houses. It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinian families resorted to Jaramana camp escaping bombing and siege of their camps specially Damascus and its Suburb.

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and Documentation team confirmed that it documents more than 3031 Palestinian Syrian died due to ongoing war in Syria till today. Bombing led to 1046 Palestinian refugee victims, clashes between the Regular Army and Opposition led to 665 Palestinian Syrian victims, and 418 victims died due to torture in the Syrian Regime's



prisons. It is referred that AGPS invites the researchers, activists, and human rights organizations to reach its statistics through the AGPS website actionpal.org.uk

Numbers and Statistics till 3/10/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 824 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 894 days, water was cut for 384 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 685 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 886 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 530 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
