RECENT UPDATES

The AGPS' correspondent reported hundreds of PRS families running away towards Al-Yarmouk Valley and other places escaping the clashes between ISIS and the opposition forces.

Clashes have been intensified in Jillin and Saham Towns during the last few days, which forced part of the Palestinians families to seek safety in caves and tents in Al-Yarmouk Valley, while others headed to Al-Ajami Valley and Al-Muzireeb town, some of them remained homeless. Meanwhile, there were reports of tens of civilians killed due to shelling and clashes.



While in Daraa, children of the camp placed flours on the grave of their fellow "Ahmad Abdulaal" who was killed by the regime's sniper shots yesterday.

Abdulaal from Daraa Camp was not the first child to be killed in the war, as the AGPS has documented 196 Palestinian Children killed due to the

war all over the country, as follows: 107 due to shelling, 14 due to sniper shots, 7 due to gunshots, 21 drowned, 17 due to car bombs, 24 due to siege and medical aid shortage, 1 was burned alive, 1 was suffocated, 1 was run over by car, and 1 was kidnaped and killed.



The monitoring and documentation team of the AGPS said the number of children victims is more likely to be higher than that, as the correspondents and the team are, sometimes, not able to verify the age of victims nor the incident itself as a result of the security condition and the risks in the field.

ARREST

The Syrian Security is still arresting the Palestinian young man "Ali Mahmoud Mahmoud" 33-year-old since 20 February 2014, from Al-Yarmouk camp, with no more information about him so far.

Palestinians from Syria in numbers and statistics Until 4 April 2016

- 15,000 Palestinian refugee from Syria in Jordan,
- 6,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics of July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian refugee from Syria arrived Europe by the end of December 2015.
- Al-Yarmouk Camp: still under the siege imposed by Syrian Regime's Army and the PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command for 1024 days. Power cut for 1085 days, water cut for 574 days. The number of victims resulting from the siege is 186.
- Al-Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning to their houses for 880 days.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1072 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: water cut continues for 733 days. 70% of its buildings are destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-Aedein camp of Hama: A relatively quiet situation with economic crises.
- Khan Eshieh Camp: All roads linking the camp to the city are still closed back and forth except for Zakia-Khan Eshieh road.
