The AGPS participates in the activities of the Palestinians of Europe 14th conference, to be held in 7 May at Malmo City in Sweden, as it seeks to reflect the suffering of Palestinian refugees in Syria, and try to deliver their voices to the various international forums and conferences.

The AGPS will carry out an art exhibition includes a collection of images that highlight the suffering of Palestinian refugees in the Palestinian camps in Syria..

A group of Palestinian artists from Yarmouk and Khan Al Shieh camps will also participate in the conference, including the well-known caricature artist, Hani Abbas, from Yarmouk and resides in



Switzerland. He will participate with a number of paintings that reflect the humanitarian suffering in Syria.

Meanwhile, the artist, Ma'moun Al Shayeb, from Yarmouk and resides in the Swedish city of Landskrona, will also addresses the suffering of the Palestinian refugees from another side by using fine art to reflect the suffering of the Yarmouk people and boats of death. The Palestinian artist, Yahya Ashmawi, from Yarmouk and resides in the Sweden city of Helsingborg, will participate with Cartoon characters that



reflect the suffering of the Palestinians of Syria in general, and the people of Yarmouk in particular, through a unique artistic style.

Meanwhile, the artist, Ghasan Shihab, from Khan Al Shieh camp and resides in Germany, will participate with paintings drawn with coal and pencils, which reflect the suffering of the Palestinian refugees in Syria.

The photojournalist, Fadi Khattab, from the Yarmouk refugee camp and a resident of the Swedish city of Atobora, participates with a number of photographs that were taken during varying periods in the Yarmouk refugee camp, which document many phases and moments experienced by the Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus.

For his part, "Ahmed Hussein," the AGPS Coordinator, stressed on the importance of the Palestinians of Europe Conference as an event where thousands of Palestinians participate in it in Europe, pointing out the importance of highlighting the suffering of Palestinians of Syria during the conference, stressing the keenness of the AGPS to pay greater attention to this file, especially from both media and human rights sides, including exhibitions and workshops that will be held during the international conferences.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS participated in a number of international events and conferences, the latest was the human rights conference in Geneva, in an attempt to bring the suffering of the Palestinians of Syria to various Arab and international bodies, including international and human rights organizations.



Victims

The Palestinian refugee, Ibraheem Abu Shaqra, who was born in 1989, from Yarmouk, died due to wounds he attained while helping injuries in Aleppo city, raising the number of Palestinian refugees, who died in Aleppo since the beginning of events, to 182 victims, including 51 refugees from Al Nairab camp and 40 refugees from Handarat camp.



Recent Updates

Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee, Ziad Awad, 43 years from Muzareeb compound southern Syria, when he went to receive his salary from Daraa camp, noting that the AGPS documented the names of 12 Palestinian detainees from Muzareeb compound in Daraa, including a woman, while they are still unaccounted for until this moment.

Muzareeb town south of Deraa camp inhabited with about 8500 refugees, in addition to a number of families who were displaced from Deraa camp.

In the meantime, the AGPS received many messages demanding the AGPS to highlight the unstable legal situation faced by the Palestinian and Syrian refugees in Turkey, especially in terms of the requirement of



the Turkish authorities to obtain a travel permission, before movement between the Turkish States, and the prevention of those authorities any refugee who did not gets a permission to travel or to visit his family until obtaining it from the Department of immigration.

Under the resolution, which came into force on January 5, it is obligatory for the Syrian refugees to obtain data proving allowance of the Turkish immigration departments in the US, by traveling to another state.

According to unofficial statistics, the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Turkey estimates at 6000-8000 refugees scattered at Istanbul, middle, and south Turkey.

The AGPS confirmed that 407 Palestinian refugees died while fighting alongside the Syrian Regime forces. The AGPS published a statistical report on the beginning of May 2016, which indicated that 158 refugees died while fighting alongside the PLA that obliges every Palestinian refugee who completed 18 years to join to obligatory military service.

Meanwhile, 39 Palestinian member of the PFGC died, in addition to 52 refugees died while fighting alongside the so-called Al Quds brigades, which is an armed group was established in the North of Syria, as it is affiliated with the Syrian Army and fight alongside it in more than area.

24 refugees died while fighting alongside Fatah Al-Intifada, while 80 refugees died while fighting alongside public groups and committees affiliated with the Syrian Security branches.



The AGPS published, within its report, detailed statistics about the victims, the detainees, and the distribution of Palestinian Syrian refugees at the Arab Countries, Turkey, and Europe due to the war in Syria.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 04\05\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1054 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1115 days, water was cut for 604 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*



- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 908 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1099 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 761 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
