#### **Victims**

Foad Hassan Awad, the Palestinian refugee, and Mosa Mhawesh a fighter of Palestine Liberation Army were killed in the ongoing clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition Groups in Tal Swan village in Adra in Damascus suburb.



#### **Recent Updates**

Hundreds of the Palestinian families ,who were displaced from the Yarmouk camp to Qadsya area, called the Palestinian Embassy in Damascus to put an end to their suffering, end the siege, and to provide them with food, medication, and help them to get back to their homes and properties. This appeal came due to the miserable living condition, high cost of living, and unemployment, in addition to the high rents, which led to economic and financial crisis at the top of losing their houses and properties.

Their suffering is aggravating due to the security deterioration in the region between the Syrian opposition and the regular army from time to time, and also because of the detentions committed by the regular army and the closure of roads that connect Qudsayya town and the city

center, which negatively affected them and forced many families to displace again from Qudsaya town to areas inside Damascus and its Suburb.

Um Abed, one of the women refugees stranded in Qudsayya says, "We escaped the Yarmouk camp thinking that the situation outside is better, but it seems that our people in the camp and their situation are better. We live in Qudsayya only because of food, money and paying the rent of house, we no longer tolerate this situation, especially that no one represents us, and we are contingent upon the link between the regular army and armed opposition groups".



It is mentioned that about 6000 Palestinian families who were displaced from the Yarmouk camp and the other camps in Qadsyyah camp, many of them live in refuges because they could not pay the rent.

In another context, Palestinians of Turkey and Homeland Causes conference event lunched yesterday with presence of Turkish parliamentarians, Palestinian personalities, and dozens of official institutions, and Palestinian NGOs in Turkey. The conference involved workshops, and many events, one of these workshops discussed the Palestinian of Turkey legal status.

The committee discussed the suffering of Palestinians of Syria in Turkey, particularly with regard to the residency, legal status, and the ways to solve the problems that the refugees face there, and the emphasis on the Turkish side to put an end to these problems. The workshops also discussed the Palestinian relief in general and the problems that face the relief processes that target the Palestinian of Syria refugees.



In a related context, the house of Palestine for poetry and Return Belief devoted its participation in the Conference of Palestinians of Turkey to highlight the suffering of Palestinian of Syria refugees especially the trips through the boats of death.

The exhibition contained a presentation of photos that summarizes the refugees suffering while travelling through the Mediterranean Sea, in addition to presenting some life vest models and inflatable boat to attract their attention to the suffering of the refugees. The exhibition also presented a recording of a drama work that deals with the story of Syrian refugees across the Mediterranean Sea, and their suffering.

For his part, Professor "Samir Attia," Head of the House of Palestine for poetry and Return Belief" assured on the need of representing the suffering of the Palestinian of Syria from the cultural aspect, and harness poetry and artwork to show g the refugees voice to the world public opinion. He also mentioned many artworks and cultural campaigns that carried out by the Palestine House for Poetry on the subject, including "death sails' that dozens of poets from various countries participated in shedding light on the risks that the Palestinian refugees were incurred during the travelling across the sea.

The Conference of Palestinians of Turkey was held in Istanbul, this morning with the participation of Palestinian. The conference discussed many of the Palestinian national issues, aiming to improve the Palestinians situation in Turkey from various legal, political and relief aspects.

### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 4\09\2016

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016

- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1174 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1235 days, water was cut for 724 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1025 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1219 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 878 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
