VICTIMS

The Palestinian refugee, "Ismael Saleh Aljalali", died as he was fighting alongside with the Assad forces. Aljalali, from Al-Sayeda Zainb camp, has been killed during the battle against the Syrian opposition troops, bringing the number of Palestinian victims from Al-Sayeda Zainb camp to (48) since the outbreak of Syrian conflict.


UPDATES

The Palestinian refugee camp of Al-Neirab was subjected to renewed shelling last night. The bombing has targeted few different areas in the camp by mortars. Two mortars have been fired to the railway line south of the camp, while two others were bombed on the farmlands. One house was hit by a mortar resulted in material damages.

It is worth mentioning that Al-Neirab camp is fully subjected to the regime control. The camp constitutes a very strategic site as it is located close to Aleppo airport, which runs the civil and military operations.

On the other context, AGPS monitoring and documentation team said they documented (3121) Palestinian victims killed during the Syrian conflict.

The statistics unveiled that (1057) have died due to the bombing operations, whereas, (703) killed where the clashes between the two parties, opposition and Assad regime had erupted. AGPS team added that (431) Palestinians were tortured to death in prisons. It is indicated that all documents are available for free on the AGPS website:

In Germany, "Fuad Abu Sameer" has joined one of the most important research centres in the country. Abu Sameer, a Palestinian refugee from Syria, became an intern in "Desy" institution which is specialized in researches of technology and electronics. The 27-year-old youth is currently under three-months internship. He will gain a full membership in "Desy" if he managed to pass successfully the stage.

It is noteworthy that Abu Sameer is a Palestinian refugee from Al-Husseinieh camp, he speaks English and German. In addition to his degree in computer sciences, Fuad has an experience in his field as he worked, previously, in a company specialised in developing computer software in Syria before he flees the war-torn country.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics

Until 5 February 2016

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 965 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1027 days, water cut for 514 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 185 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 821 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1014 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 675 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.
