

Recent Updates

Our correspondent in the Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus confirmed that there was an alert and suspicious actions of ISIS members in the Yarmouk camp, where these actions are believed to be preparing for a new attack against Nusra areas (The Sham Liberation Organization).

ISIS set up several new earth mounds in Haifa, Safuriya, and Lubya Streets, as it raised the number of fighters in the axes of Khamastaash Street to Thalathin Street.



A few days ago, ISIS launched an attack against points of the Sham Liberation Organization, which resulted in dozens of deaths and injuries among the two organizations.

The correspondent also reported a large state of fear and panic among the civilians who are besieged in the area of The Sham Liberation Organization because of violent clashes that prevent them from leaving the area and providing water and food. ISIS had taken control of Yarmouk camp in coordination with Nusra members in April 2015.

Sources from Alquds Brigade, which is affiliated with the Syrian regime, confirmed that the Brigade was preparing to attack ISIS in the Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus as part of the Regime's operation to restore several towns south of Damascus.

An official of the Palestine Liberation Organization in Syria revealed an agreement states the withdrawal of Nusra members from the Yarmouk camp. After their withdrawal, ISIS will choose either to withdraw or to be attacked by a military operation.

The camp is under strict siege imposed by the Syrian regime and PF - General Command groups for 1387 days, while ISIS controlled large areas in early April 2015 with the assistance and support of Nusra Front.

The Syrian regime continues to detain the Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Mahmoud Alqasim," who is from the Yarmouk camp, for the fifth year in a row without knowing his fate. He was arrested by the Syrian security forces and groups near al-Bashir Mosque in the Yarmouk refugee camp.

Meanwhile, his family and friends appealed anyone who has information or could see him inside the prisons to communicate with the Action Group.

The AGPS receives many letters and information about the Palestinian detainees, and documents it in turn despite the difficulties of documentation in light of the Syrian regime's continued concealment of the detainees' fate and their names and places of detention. The group has documented 1189 Palestinian detainees in the prisons of the Syrian regime, including 87 women.

Civil Work Committees

Jafra Foundation distributed aid for the residents of Khan Al Shieh camp in the western suburb of Damascus within "Qameh and Hanoun" campaign. The campaign contained food packages, blankets, pillows, and baby milk. The aids were distributed by volunteers.

The volunteers of this relief campaign expressed their contentment, as they said that it is a part of their social responsibility towards their camp.

Meanwhile, the Syrian regime continues to tighten the security control and siege over the camp, as it prevents medication, gas, fuel, and batteries that are used for lightening, in addition to the prevention of residents to return back to the camp, as well as the arrest campaigns between now and then.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 05\05\2017

- The AGPS documented 3488 Palestinian victims, including 455 women.
- 1190 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 87 women.
- The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1387 consecutive days.
- 1955 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.
- It is now more than 1118 days without water in Deraa camp, and 969 days in the Yarmouk camp.
- Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 14622 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 196 days.
- Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.
