

#### **Recent Updates**

The Yarmouk camp for Palestinian Refugees in Damascus was exposed yesterday to targeting with mortar shells on separate areas of the camp, which led to two injuries, the group knew the refugee Ghalia Mustafa and she was allowed by the Regular Army to get out of the camp for treatment in the Damascus hospitals. Moreover, the Regular Army allowed for Mr. Deeb Sadeyya and the two children Qassem and Hashem Farah to get out of the camp for treatment.

It is noteworthy that all the hospitals and clinics of the camp stopped working except Palestine Hospital, which offers some simple medical services, where the siege imposed by the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command on the camp stops the work of those facilities.

A number of Palestinian E- Pages close to the Syrian regime, circulated a copy of a statement attributed to the 14 Palestinian factions located in Syria, the statement stressed on the implementation of the Palestinian Initiative signed on "06/21/2014", supported by the Syrian leadership in order to return people to their homes at the Yarmouk camp, according to the statement.

The statement pointed out that after the militants inside the camp condemn the activists assassinations which led to the death of Abu Ahmed Tirawih, and Abu Abed Areesha, the Factions decided to continue to distribute food and pharmaceutical aids in the Yarmouk camp, adding

that they are ready to give a new opportunity to resume dialogue with what the factions described as the militants, according to the explanatory of the mentioned agreement, and immediately forming a committee to oversee the implementation of the neutrality of camp .It is referred that the AGPS was unable to confirm the credibility of the statement.

In Damascus Suburb, Al Sayeda Zainab camp for Palestinian Refugees suffers of the consequences of the ongoing war in Syria especially from the economic side such as high cost of rent houses, food supplies and the spread of unemployment. It is mentioned that the camp is considered to be quite and calm where the Regular Army completely controls the camp and the checkpoints are available on its entrances and on the surrounding areas.

In Lathekia, the vicinity of Al Raml camp for Palestinian refugees was targeted with about three shells without any material damages. It is mentioned that Al Raml is considered to be quite and calm due to its location in Lathekia city which is fully controlled by the Regular Army. The Camp receives dozens of Palestinian families who left their camps due to bombing, siege and clashes.

In Turkey, Al Marhama started yesterday to distribute its urgent aids on hundreds of Palestinian and Syrian families of the Shelter centers in Kilis city and its suburbia. The Aids included food, blankets, and providing some sweets to children of the shelters.

It is noteworthy that thousands of Palestinian Refugees had fled from Syria to Turkey because of the bombing of their camps and involving them with in the ongoing conflict. Unofficial statistics indicate that the number of the Palestinians of Syria refugees who are in Turkey ranges between 3,000 and 5,000 refugees.

#### Civil Work Committees

Jafra Foundation for Relife and Development announced its intention to hold a poetry evening in Jaramana camp for Palestinian refugees titled as "The Glory of the Arab Poetry". Jafra referred that a number of female and male youth who are interested in poetry will participated in the evening through sharing their poems, thoughts and prose. Jafra also announced that the youth who want to participated should contact the organization before next Sunday.

On the other side, the office of the Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian people provided the Pharmacy of the charity office at Al Aedin camp in Homs with pharmaceutical and medical supplies, so as to make the pharmacy ready to receive the residents. It is mentioned that the Charity distributed earlier this month financial aids on some patients in different Palestinian camps and compounds in Syria. The Department of Development and Community Empowerment at the Charity Commission launched a project titled as "Sonna Al Ghad" to follow up the lessons of the primary stage displaced Palestinian Students at Qudseyya in Damascus Suburb.

#### AGPS, Numbers and Statistics till 5/2/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- 2632 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 579 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 659 days, water was cut for 149 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 165 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 481 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 450 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 652 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 296 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
