"Targeting Yarmouk Camp with Explosive Barrels Leads to One Victim and a Number of Wounded"

Victims

5 Palestinian refugees died yesterday in Syria due to bombing, clashes, and torture in the Syrian prisons, where the refugee Mohammed Balawna 18 years from Khan Al Sheih camp died due to torture after being arrested for 6 days. The Refugee Amjad Abu Khalifa 22 years died in the Syrian prisons after being arrested for more than 3 years and he is from Al Barameka neighborhood in Damascus. It is referred that the number of the Palestinians of Syria who died due to torture reached 422 victims, according to AGPS. In the same context, two Palestinian refugees from Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees died due to their participation in the fighting in Syria, where Ashraf Sameeh Saleh died due to participation in the fighting beside the Syrian Armyagainst the Opposition in Al Qunitera and the refugee Salman Al Shafai died due to participation in the ongoing conflict in Syria. The victims' toll of Khan Danoun camp from the Palestinian refugees reached to 35 refugee victims since the beginning of the conflict in Syria, According to AGPS.

The Palestinian refugee Tamer Mohammed from the Yarmouk camp died due to targeting the camp with explosive barrels, AGPS documented 1229 victims from the residents of Yarmouk camp since the beginning of the ongoing events in Syria.

Recent Updates


The Yarmouk camp, south of the capital Damascus, witnessed yesterday evening a new series of bombing by explosive barrels in which 9 explosive barrels fall in different parts of the camp from which the Al-Yarmouk main street near Falafel Tebah; Street 15, western Yarmouk Street, causing the death of the Palestinian refugee "Tamer Mohammed" and the fall of wounded.



The besieged Yarmouk camp is still including thousands of civilians in light of the continued siege of the Regular Army and PFGC for (827) days respectively, power outages for more than 897 days, water cut for 387 days respectively, and the continuous control of ISIS and Al-Nasrah front for about 70% of the camp.

In the south suburb of the capital Damascus, the received from Al-Saydah Zainab camp it may disturb the relative calmness. It was reported that Armed Groups of the Syrian Regime in Al-SayedaZainab district of Damascus southern suburb sieged Al-SayedaZeinab camp for

Palestinian refugees and that those groups closed the roads leading to the camp.



Al- Saydah Zainab camp

This comes after a quarrel between a young man from the camp with a close confidant of those groups in Al- Sayeda Zeinab district who in his turn opened fire on the young and injury him seriously. This prompted one of the brothers of the young victim to fire on the patrol of the armed groups and to kill two of them. The news added that the loyal armed groups in the region mobilize its members to storm Al- Sayeda Zeinab camp for Palestinian refugees and to arrest the required among them. AGPS were not given the chance to make sure from the news from other sources.

The number of Palestinian refugees, according to the latest statistics in July 2013, is about 26 774 distributed into 6214 families and neighbored by Al- Sayeda Zeinab district which is resided by mainly pro-Syrian regime. In Al- Neirab camp in Aleppo that is relatively similar to its security condition, the residents of the camp warned that the actions of the Syrian Army and groups loyal to it will immerse the camp directly in

the conflict in which the camp witness recently an active movement for Al-Quds Brigade group loyal to the Syrian regime of the security alert of its members in the camp and holding meetings under the leadership of its boss called "Mohammed Saeed" while tanks of the Syrian army moves from the camp towards the airport.

The residents of the camp are living a state of anxiety and fear as a result of these moves and military crowds carried out by the regime in Al-Neirab Airport and the rumors which are circulated by the residents of the camp about the Syrian army processing and its loyal groups to a military operation to counter the armed opposition factions in Al-Sheikh Lutfi district, west of Al-Neirab camp and west of Aleppo International Airport and military Neirab which represents a significant threat to the region in which violent clashes between the Syrian regime forces and armed opposition groups took place. It is mentioned that the airport area near Al-Neirab camp became a strategic area for the parties of the conflict in Syria which formed a baking points that protects the Syrian regime and its loyal groups in front of the opposition armed factions.

Detainees

The Popular Committee that is affiliated to the Syrian Security arrested the Palestinian refugee Khalid Jamal Zwawi 30 years. He is from Al Muzareeb Compound for Palestinian refugees. He was arrested in the Alloja area between Daraa and Al Swedaa Governorates south of Syria while he was travelling to Turkey, which raises the Detainees toll of Daraa Governorates from the Palestinian refugees to 46 detainees.

Numbers and Statistics till 6/10/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 827 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 897 days, water was cut for 387 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 688 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 889 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 533 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
