#### **Victims**

The Palestinian refugee "Mohammad Al Sofi" died because of siege, lack of medicine and medical care in the camp.

According to AGPS documented statistics, the number of Palestinian refugees who died because of siege and lack of medical care has reached (189) victims.

Moreover, "Omar Shalabi" a Palestinian refugee from Neirab camp, was killed in a bombardment targeted Al -Bab city in Aleppo's Northeast countryside. It's worth noting that Shalabi had immigrated 4 years ago from Neirab escaping from siege which was imposed by the armed opposition groups.

And according to AGPS documented statistics, the number of Palestinian refugees who were killed since the beginning of war in Syria has reached (3363) victims.

### Recent Updates

Aerial bombardment on Khan Al-Sheih causes 3 victims and a number of casualties. For more details, AGBS reporter in Damascus countryside stated that Russian and Syrian aircrafts had targeted yesterday the eastern part of the camp with cluster bombs, which led to the death of a child of

one year and a half called "Esraa", number of injuries, fire in the camp and massive destruction in the area.

Yesterday, the camp witnessed heavy artillery and missile strikes targeted Al Huda mosque, western and eastern lanes in the camp. As a result, the Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Husian – Abu Nidal" and a displaced young man from Darayya town were killed and number of civilians were intermediately injured after the Russian -Syrian aircrafts had shelled the western lane with one Grad rocket. In addition to a widespread panic and tension among civilians who lived difficult conditions after the security deterioration in the area.

AGPS reporter confirmed that Khan Al-Sheih residents suffer from severe lack of foodstuffs, bread and drinking water. It's good to remind that in the past food supplies had been delivered through Khan Al-Sheih- Zakia road.



Adding, living conditions in the camp alert with a real humanitarian catastrophe; since the Syrian regime had closed all the leading roads to

the camp trying to impose a suffocating siege and set his own conditions like what had happened in Darayya.

It's worth mentioning that the few last weeks witnessed a rapid increase of airstrikes on Khan Al -Sheih. Therefore, there were dozens of victims and injuries among residents and displaced families, who left their houses escaping from shelling and explosive barrels.

In the meantime, Daraa camp in the south of Syria witnessed artillery bombardments on different places in the camp with material damages. Lanes of Daraa Al- Balad and Al-Sadd road had exposed to artillery and missile strikes. Moreover, aircrafts had dropped an explosive cylinder which destroyed houses and frightened civilians.



It's noteworthy that many Palestinian families and those who immigrate from Daraa live in Al-Balad and Al-Sadd's lane. Refugees who still live in Daraa suffer from dangerous humanitarian situations in health and living conditions. In addition to water cut for 909 consecutive days, shells and clashes that have destroyed nearly 70% of the camp according to uncertain resources.

Reportedly, from time to time there are fierce clashes between Syrian regime and armed opposition groups in the surrounding farms of Khan Dannoun. High tension among people in Alderkhbayh and Almquilibh areas because of the sounds of bullets and artillery shells.

Some news reported that some fighters from Khan Dannoun, who are affiliates to the Syrian regime, are spreading in the camp to secure it.

It should be noted that people of Khan Dannoun suffer from lack of relief services especially they live in difficult economic conditions. There aren't any charities or civil work committees inside the camp because of arrests and security restrictions. Khan Dannoun considered as the poorest Palestinian camp among others in Syria; its people depend on UNRWA's relief aids which are distributed from time to time.

### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 6/10/2016

- (15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.
- (42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.
- (6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.
- (8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.
- (1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.
- More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.
- Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1206) consecutive days. Power cut continued

for more than (1267) days. water was cut for (757) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).

- Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1059) days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about (1251) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Daraa Camp: It is now almost (909) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
