"Clashes between "Aknaf Bait Al-Maqdes Brigades" and "Al-Ansar Group" in Yarmouk"



- Death of a close associate to "Al-Quds Brigade" due to road-side bomb in Aleppo.

- Warplanes launch airstrikes at areas around Khan Eshieh Camp.

VICTIMS

The Palestinian Syrian "Mohammad Haidar" 63 years in his car was targeted by a road-side bomb in New Aleppo district in Aleppo. "Haidar" was seen as one of the best supporters of Al-Quds pro-regime brigade in Aleppo which is a militia fights alongside with the Syrian regime and has tens of Palestinian Syrians members.


In the meantime, "Aknaf Bait Al-Maqdes Brigades" announced death of its member "Abed Siyam" who was killed during clashes occurred at Palestine roundabout area between them and "Al-Ansar Group" which pledged alliance to ISIS.



RECENT UPDATES

Violent clashes took place at Yarmouk refugees camp between "Aknaf Bait Al-Maqdes Bigades" and the ISIS pledged alliance "Al-Ansar Group". According to military source related to "Aknaf Brigades"; their forces confronted an infiltration try of "Al-Ansar Group" towards the Hospital point near Palestine roundabout, pointing that the clashes resulted in many injuries and victims. The refugee "Abed Siyam" was identified as dead.

It is noteworthy that the so-called ISIS had broken into Yarmouk refugee camp south of Damascus in April 2015, in collusion with "Al-Nusra Front" which handed over its areas to ISIS, these areas formed the starting point for ISIS to attack and take in the rest of areas inside Yarmouk.



In a different context, the surrounding areas of Khan Eshieh refugees camp was hit by heavy shelling by warplanes which targeted the farms there with four raids at least. In the meantime, the Syrian Regime's army continues closing all the roads to the camp back and forth.

Turning towards the north, Hama camp has been hosting a large number of displaced families came from camps and cities of Damascus, Aleppo, Idlib and Deir Ezzor and Raqqa and Deraa and Latakia.

Hama camp lives in a state of relative stability compared to the rest of the camps in Syria. However, people are suffering from the security procedures imposed by the regime's army at the entrances and exits of the camp, in addition to the raids and arrests every now and then.

Regarding the economic situation, people suffer from the widespread unemployment due to the tense security situation; many of them lost their work and become completely dependent on relief aid.



STATISTICS

The monitoring and documentation team at AGPS confirmed 1014 arrest and enforced disappearance cases concerning Palestinian refugees across the camps in Syria.

The monitoring and documentation team believes that the real number could be more than 1,500 arrestees since fears and threats prevent families from disclosing the arrest of their sons.

It is worth mentioning that 426 Palestinian refugees were tortured to death in the prisons of the Syrian regime, most of them ended up this way after being detained for long periods.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 6 December 2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFGC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 888 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 958 days, water cut for 448 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 749 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 950 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Water cut continues for 594 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Homs and Aedein Hamma: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
