"Shelling at the Yarmouk Camp and a Resident Dies Due to Torture in the Syrian Prisons"

Victims

The AGPS received news about the death of the young man Ali Ahmed Shuqair who died due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons after he was arrested by the Yarmouk camp checkpoint while he was leaving the camp, the AGPS couldn't assure this news. Bringing the torture death to 297 victims were documented by the AGPS, while 777 Palestinian detainees still detained in the Syrian prisons who were arrested during the war events in Syria.

Meanwhile, the Palestinian refugee Khalid Mustafa Rahhal was found killed in one of the orchards at Ain Al Hilwa camp. In details, the people of Ain Al Hilwa camp found a body in a bag and dumped in an orchard of the city of Sidon south of Lebanon, upon detection, the body belongs to the Palestinian Syrian refugee "Khalid Mustafa Rahhal" who was lost a few weeks ago. Neither the cause of death nor the killer were identified and the body was transferred to Al Hamshari Hospital in the city of Sidon.

Recent Updates

A number of shells targeted different areas of the Yarmouk Palestinian refugee camp in Damascus, yesterday, where the bombing targeted Palestine mosque in conjunction with the presence of worshipers for Friday prayers, which resulted in a state of panic and tension among them. Al Maghariba Street and the vicinity of Al Siwar Hall were also targeted with a number of shells.



Meanwhile, the relief urgent aid distribution continued for the besieged residents inside the camp, where the distribution was at Yarmouk municipality. This distribution came after one day of distributing more than 300 share of food aid and it is scheduled to continue the distribution for several days until it covers all the families of the Yarmouk refugee camp.

The camp is still under the siege imposed by the Syrian army and the General Command groups for (608) days respectively, while the power cut for more than 688 days, the water cut for 178 days respectively, and the high number of siege victims that reached to (172) victims.

In the same context, the displaced families from the Yarmouk who are in the Algerian shelter Center "Taher" demanded revving the actions of opening the way for their return to their homes in the camp, due to their suffering worsening outside their homes. The displaced refugees complained about the hard living conditions, where many families share only one room in the school. It is referred that Tahir Algerian School is one of the largest shelters in Al Zahira area in Damascus, and the estimated number of families in this place is 51 families from the Yarmouk refugee camp.

The residents of Al Sayeda Zainab camp suffer of compound economic and living conditions where unemployment and high cost of living are most significant suffering in addition to securing the bread and the lack of fuel and heating materials which forced the residents to use old heating means. It is mentioned that the camp receives hundreds of displaced Palestinian families from the Yarmouk camp, Al Husaeyneyya



camp and other surrounding areas which led to the high cost of rent houses.

In a different context, Al Quds brigade which is affiliated to the Regular Army arrested the two refugees Ahmed Zakareya Abu Rahma and Anas Ahmed Azzam and they are 16 years old from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo, where they were taken to an unknown place. The Syrian Security released the refugee Abu Karem Al Refi after being arrested for several days.

On the other hand, the Palestinians of Syria committee in Lebanon in cooperation with the Syrian Charity Organization "Khair" distributed 100 children milk for the camps children who are under one year. It is mentioned that 1050 Palestinian Syrian families live in Al Beddawi camp.



In a different side, the AGPS received news about missing the Syrian Palestinian young man Ahmed Khalid Hasan after he was on a boat that was launched from Libya to Italy. It is mentioned that Libya is considered the most famous station to reach Europe in illegal ways, where thousands of different nationalities and Palestinians of Syria refugees died drowning due to the Death Boats that they had to ride although the boats unrediness for those trips.





Numbers and Statistics till 63/2015:-

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2680 Palestinian victims were documented by the AGPS.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 608 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 688 days, water was cut for 178 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 172 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 510 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 479 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 681 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 325 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
