"Clashes Break Out Again in the Al-Yarmouk Between ISIS and Al-Nusra Front"

VICTIMS

The Palestinian man "Hasan Abu Allil" 37-year-old from Al-Nayrab camp was announced dead after being injured by shelling on Al-Bab town in Aleppo.

This incident brings up the total number of Palestinian victims to 3199 since the beginning of the war in Syria.

RECENT UPDATES

Al-Yarmouk camp has witnessed mutual clashes and sniping between ISIS and Al-Nusra. Both of the fighting parties have raised blinding curtains on roads' intersections, dug holes through the walls and shops in Lubiya street to facilitate the mobility across neighborhoods away from sniper shots.

Clashes have taken place at the 15th street, Haifa, Jaouna, and Safad streets inside the camp, where ISIS is trying to cut the supply-routes of Al-Nusra Front.

Activists said, at least one youth was shot by a sniper near Abdulqader Al-Hossayni Mosque. While ISIS managed to impose its control over Al-Orouba barrier which divides the Al-Yarmouk from Yalda Town. In the meantime, unremitting attempts is going on to end the tension.

Activists reported two youths affiliated to the Al-Nusra executed by ISIS after being arrested from Al-Qadam Neighborhood.

it is noteworthy that ISIS and Al-Nusra Front had imposed their mutual control over the camp since April 2015 after eliminating Al-Aknaf Brigades. While the Syrian regime is still besieging the camp for 1027 days, cutting electricity for 1088 day, and water for 577 days.



In Damascus Countryside, Khan Eshieh camp were exposed to sporadic shelling launched, according to activists, from Al-Kabousiyya hill where the regime's troops are positioned.

This shelling was followed by heavy machineguns bursts which caused a fire to break out in one of the houses near the camp's graveyard, and injured a woman.

In Eastern Gota of Damascus Countryside, the conscript "Omar Ahmad Al-Naji" from PLA was injured during clashes.

Al-Naji, who is a resident of Handarat Camp in Aleppo, got his injury in clashes between the regime and the opposition forces.

This incident comes after a similar one few days ago, when four Palestinian conscripts were killed during fighting alongside the regime's army, raising the total PLA victims to 172 since the beginning of the war.

Palestinians from Syria in numbers and statistics Until 7 April 2016

- 15,000 Palestinian refugee from Syria in Jordan,
- 6,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics of July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian refugee from Syria arrived Europe by the end of December 2015.
- Al-Yarmouk Camp: still under the siege imposed by Syrian Regime's Army and the PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command for 1027 days. Power cut for 1088 days, water cut for 577 days. The number of victims resulting from the siege is 186.
- Al-Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning to their houses for 883 days.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1075 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: water cut continues for 736 days. 70% of its buildings are destroyed.

- Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-Aedein camp of Hama: A relatively quiet situation with economic crises.
- Khan Eshieh Camp: All roads linking the camp to the city are still closed back and forth except for Zakia-Khan Eshieh road.
