#### **Victims**

The Palestinian refugee "Tamer Ibrahim," a member of one of the Palestinian committees, which is fighting alongside the Syrian regime, died due to clashes on the Yarmouk Municipality in Palestine Street.


The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented more than (3334) Palestinian Syrian who died due to the ongoing war in Syria until today.

#### Recent Updates

The families of more than 1100 Palestinian detainees in the Syrian prisons suffer from absence of knowledge about the fate of their sons, where they were detained without mentioning their place, reasons of detention or any information about their health status.



This opened the door for the so-called detainees' dealers and most of them are security officers in the Syrian Security Branches or closed to them, where they blackmailed the families of the detainees for getting

information about the prisoners and the little information reached \$2000 sometimes. Some Big Officers take about \$10000 as a cost to release some detainees.

Families added that most of those "swindlers" who take money and providing false information about the detainees, or disagree with the families, and stop any way to communicate with them after taking money.

In northern Syria, the AGPS correspondent reported news that the Syrian security forces arrested five Palestinian refugees from Neirab camp in Aleppo. In detail, our correspondent confirmed that Syrian security forces raided and broke into five refugee houses and then arrested them without knowing the reasons behind the arrest.

The reporter pointed out that the detainees are: Abed Harb, Nadeem Abu Hasan, Ahmed Shatara, Eyad Jouhar, while the fifth detainee was not known yet.

It is noteworthy that the Syrian security services continue to be reticent about the fate of more than 1,100 Palestinian refugees in its jails, and in spite of the continuous appeals to release them. The detainees include children, women, elderly, brothers, fathers, sons, and entire families, while hundreds of them died due to torture.

At the Syrian-Lebanese border, the Palestinian Syrian student, Aya Tayseer Shihada, who are stranded on the Lebanese border, launched a distress call to the international and local organizations, human rights organizations, the PLO, and the Palestinian factions to put pressure on the Lebanese government in order to allow her to enter its territory.

In details, the AGPS received news that the Lebanese General Security prevented the Palestinian Syrian student, Aya Tayseer Shihada, from entering Lebanese territory, even though she came out of Lebanon systematically with the church complex in May 2016 in order to perform the (brevet) exam in Syria. After the exams, Aya had a disease in her foot, and had a surgery of planting a leg articulatio, and had to stay three months in bed to regain her health. Aya decided to return to live with her family who was displaced to Lebanon since 2013.



Her family consists of her mother and two sisters, but when she arrived at the Lebanese border at around 11:00 am yesterday, she was surprised that security agents prevented her from entering the Lebanese territory, although she carries the number of telegram that she came under to Syria.

They asked her to wait, but hours passed while she is waiting in the car despite the fact that her health condition does not allow it without receiving any replies.

Accordingly, Aya Tayseer Shihada, appealed the Palestinian ambassador and the Palestinian factions in Lebanon through the AGPS to consider

the health and humanitarian status and mediate with the Lebanese government in order to be reunited with her family, who lived with them in Lebanon since 2013.

It is worth mentioning that the AGPS observed several cases of preventing Palestinian Syrian students from returning to Lebanon after performing exams in Syria, which led to the breakup of family between Lebanon and Syria.


In the Netherlands, dozens of Palestinian Syrian refugees participated on campaign against the visit of Prime Minister of the Zionist entity Netanyahu to the Kingdom of the Netherlands, as part of joint efforts undertaken by a number of Palestinian institutions in the Netherlands.

The Palestinian community in Netherlands sit-in in solidarity with the cause of Palestine yesterday afternoon Tuesday 6-9 in front of the Dutch Parliament, as a confirmation to refuse the visit of the head of the Israeli government to the Netherlands.

Palestinian people, as well as a large model of the Palestinian Return key, as they shouted, refusing the visit of the criminal Netanyahu blaming him of responsibility for the killing of innocent children of Palestine.

The delegation of (Not Welcome) campaign presented a petition for the Dutch parliament expressing their rejection which of receiving Benjamin Netanyahu in the parliament, and this petition was signed by the people of Palestine and peace activists in the Netherlands.

In turn, the AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented nearly 12 victims who died during August 2016, while 50 s refugee died in the same month in 2015 as a result of the continuing conflict in Syria. The AGPS noted that victims who died in August 2016 were dispersed by the Syrian cities as follows: 3 refugees in Khan Al Shieh camp, 4 refugees in Daraa, two refugees in the eastern Ghouta, one refugee died at the entrance of Handarat camp, and two refugees died in different places.

The AGPS pointed out that the "50" victims who were killed in August 2015 dispersed by the Syrian cities as follows: 6 refugees in Damascus, 10 refugees in Damascus suburb, 12 refugees in Daraa, 2 refugees in the Lebanese city of Sidon, one refugee in Swaidaa, one refugee in Idlib, and 17 refugees were killed in scattered areas.

### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 7\09\2016

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon

- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1177 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1238 days, water was cut for 727 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1030 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1222 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 881 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
