Victims

Three Palestinian victims died yesterday due to the ongoing conflict in Syria; they are:

The Palestinian refugee "Said Shuraitah" from the Yarmouk camp, died due to a sniper shot while he was in Palestine Street.

Each of "Raed Yousef" and "Alaa Asaad" Palestinian refugees died during participation fighting alongside the Syrian army and security forces. They are from Jaramana camp in Damascus suburb.

Recent Updates

A state of cautious calm prevailed Yarmouk south of Damascus yesterday after being targeted with 9 explosive barrels, which led to the death of one victim and a number of wounded, and caused significant damage to homes and streets.

The Palestinian refugee " Said Shuraitah" died by a sniper shot while he was in Palestine Street.



Meanwhile, residents and relief bodies remaining in the camp removed the rubble and debris caused by the bombing of the camp.

The regular army and PFGC groups are still imposing siege on the camp for 828 days respectively, while power cut for more than 898 days and water for 388 days, in addition to ISIS and Nusra control over approximately 70% of the camp.

In the meantime, residents of Al Aedein camp in Homs are still suffering from significant harassment by Syrian security forces, at a time when the number of detainees from the camp has reached 180, according to the AGPS statistics and they are still unaccounted for.

The camp, which is controlled by the regular army, is living under an intense and unprecedented security tightening, so that its residents now feel that they are in a big prison.

On 21 June 2015, the Syrian authorities build an iron fence separates the neighborhoods of Al Aedein camp in Homs and its neighboring districts, without any service corridors between the two sides, which doubled the economic suffering and reflected negatively on their living conditions.

On the other hand, the Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Khaled Tahimr" and his 7-year-son "Muhammad" at Qamishli airport, during their attempt to reach Turkey, then they were transferred to one of the security branches in Damascus.

The Syrian security called his wife and asked her to come to take her son, and when asked about the fate of her husband the security member answered "Forget your husband and do not ever ask about him".

It is noteworthy that testimonies of some released detainees confirmed the presence of children, infants, mothers, and elderly of the Palestinian refugees, while the AGPS documented 978 Palestinian prisoners.

Hamas

Hamas movement issued a press release in which it denied the charges of interfere in the internal affairs of Syria, where the charges came after Syria TV broadcasted an interview on Friday 2/10/2015 with the leader of Aknaf "Mamoun Galoda Abu Jaafar".



Mr. Abu Jaafar was recently arrested at Beit Sahem-Yalda checkpoint by members of the Syrian regime, which he confessed to having links with Hamas.

In turn, Hamas stressed in its statement, which the AGPS received a copy of it, on its firm position not to interfere in the internal affairs of any country, including Syria, and reiterated that it has nothing to do with the so-called (Aknaf),

Hamas has previously confirmed and informed the various relevant parties, and the statement noted that the movement has no battle in Syria, or any other country, and that its battle is only against the occupation. The objective of Hamas was and still to liberate the land of Palestine and the achievement of freedom and return for the Palestinian people, and establish their independent state on the entire National territory and Jerusalem as its capital.



Hamas considered that confessions and statements made by Galoda had been extracted under pressure and torture.

In the end of the statement Hamas called all concerned parties inside Syria to neutralize the Palestinian refugee camps, particularly the



Yarmouk refugee camp of current events, wishing for Syria and its Arab inherent people security, tranquility, and stability.

Lebanon

The Student Committee of the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon distributed 288 school bags equipped with all school stationery for the Palestinian Syrian students at Shatila and Burj Barajneh camps in Beirut.

It should be noted that Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon based on serving the Palestinian refugee from the Syrian camps in Lebanon, and aims to shed light on the suffering and tragedy and to help them.



Numbers and Statistics till 7/10/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*



- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 828 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 898 days, water was cut for 388 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 689 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 890 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 534 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
