### *"Shelling Targets Al Aedein Camp in Homs and Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus Suburb, and Clashes Continue in Yarmouk"*

### *Victims*

*The Palestinian refugee, Ghasan Jaber, from Al Hara Al Jadeida in Damr neighborhood- Damascus, died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, while his body was recognized within the leaked pictures of torture victims.*



*The number of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in the Syrian prisons has reached 397 victims.*



*Meanwhile, Kamal Yousef Asaad, an official at pro-Syrian regime Al Quds brigades, from AL Raml camp in Latakia died during fighting at Mahambal town-Idlib suburb.*



### *Recent Updates*

*Two missiles targeted "Jaffa" and "Bisan Hospital" Streets at Al Aedein camp in Homs, while two children were slightly injured. According to the AGPS correspondent's testimony, the Syrian opposition armed groups bombed a military barracks where Syrian regime soldiers were holed up, near Al Aedein camp, in response to the bombing of Al Waar neighborhood and Zafarana village by warplanes, which led to the fall of two missiles at Al Aedein camp in Homs, resulted in material damage where they fall.*



*In the meantime, residents of al Aedein camp in Homs complain of the continuing fly of warplanes at low height in the sky of the camp, causing powerful sound leads to a state of terror among children.*

*It is worth mentioning that warplanes are hovering continuously about two months ago, whereby the aircraft raided the neighboring areas of the camp.*



*Violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk camp South of the Syrian capital, Damascus, between Palestinian armed groups and ISIS alongside Al-Nusra Front, where confrontations centered at Al Habeeb Al Mustafa mosque, the court area, and Al Rija Square. The clashes coincided with a number of mortar shells that targeted the camp without any injuries, while ISIS still impose its control over about 60% of neighborhoods and lanes of Yarmouk.*



*Mean while, the Syrian regular army and PFGC groups impose a strict siege on the Yarmouk camp for 710 days respectively, while ISIS storming has aggravated the deteriorating humanitarian situation inside the camp.*

*On the other hand, number of shells targeted the sides of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb yesterday, which did not result in any injuries, while a state of anxiety and tension still prevails among the residents as a result of the deteriorating security situation in the adjacent regions and*



*farms, which impacted negatively on the economic and living conditions, and also led to the fall of 102 victims since the beginning of the war in Syria.*

*A number of activists of Sbeineh camp held the Syrian government and the Palestinian factions responsible of the continuation of their tragedy and suffering, as a result of the continued prevention from returning to their properties and homes who were forced to leave because of the violent clashes that broke out between the regular army and groups of armed opposition, which ended up with the regular army complete control over the camp since 7 \ 11 \ 2013.*

*Activists demanded the Syrian authorities to work in order to repair infrastructure in the camp, and to provide basic services in preparation for the return of residents to their homes.*

### *Release*

*After 5 days of detention, the Syrian security forces released the Palestinian refugee, Hasan Salim "Abu Emad," a leader of the democratic Front, and a member of Al Wusta area leadership.*

*He was detained on 1st of June 2013 at Al Qateifa checkpoint while he was heading from Homs to Damascus in order to complete family reunion procedures with his family in Germany.*

*It is worth mentioning that he is originally from Um Al Faraj village in Palestine, and he is in his eighties.*



### UNRWA

*Damascus-based Aedoun Group held a discussion session that addressed the recent procedures of UNRWA, especially those related to the issue of financial aid distribution to Palestinian refugees in Syria.*

*For their part, the audience assured to the Director General of UNRWA in Syria, Mr. Michael Kingsley, that UNRWA's recent actions are considered to be "humiliating and insulting to Palestinian refugees in Syria."*



*For his part, Director-General of UNRWA expressed his rejection of calls demanding postponement or distribution cancellation, as well as he also refused to answer a question which demanded disclosure of the party that stands behind those actions, saying only that these actions related to the United Nations which is not confined only in Syria but applied in Lebanon and Jordan.*

*The meeting was attended by Director General of UNRWA in Syria, Mr. Michael Kingsley, Director General of the Arab Authority for Palestinian*



*refugees, Mr. Ali Mustafa, and "34" character of various Palestinian compounds and camps in Damascus.*

*According to Aedoun group, the results of this meeting will appear during the next two days.*

### *Italy*

*Italian Coast Guard announced that they rescued more than 2000 immigrants were threatened with drowning in the Mediterranean in collaboration with Italian, Irish, and German ships, while sources confirmed that migrants who hold different nationalities were on board five wooden boats in the Mediterranean Sea off the Libyan coast."*

*UNHCR reported that 46,500 immigrants arrived in Italy by sea during the first five months of 2015, an increase of 12 %in compare with the same period last year. The Italian government expects that the number will reach 200,000 people this year.*

### *Numbers and Statistics till 76/2015*

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*



- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 883 detainees, and 397 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 710 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 780 days, water was cut for 270 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 591 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 572 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 774 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 417 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
