#### **Victims**

The Palestinian Refugee Mahmoud Shaaban from Yarmouk died due to an Incurable disease, while he left the camp for treatment after the deterioration of his health because of siege and lack of medical care.



#### **Recent Updates**

ISIS detains group Palestinian refugees from Deraa camp five days ago, while the ground for detention was unclear so far.

The group launched from areas controlled by the Syrian opposition southern Syria, and walked through the desert, through Lajja area for being outside the control of the Syrian regime fields until they reached Almayadeen area at Deirez-Zor province where they were arrested by members of ISIS.

It is noteworthy that fear of detention by the Syrian regime and its checkpoints prompted dozens of families and individuals of Palestinian refugees to choose ways far from areas controlled by the regime; such as the Syrian Desert, in spite of the seriousness of those roads and the high cost of smuggling.

On the other hand, residents of Nairab camp in Aleppo complain of continued power cut ten days ago, as a result of the ongoing conflict in the thermal station and Zorba area between the Syrian army and the armed opposition groups.

Residents of the camp also suffers from water cut for two days ago, while residents rely on well water, which increased the burdens, in addition to the high costs of living, widespread of unemployment, and weak financial resources in light of the ongoing war events in the country.

This coincided with the sand storm that hit the region and the camp accompanied with high temperatures, which reached 40 degrees Celsius, as the camp witnesses instability and unsafety state due to the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas, and the involvement of some of its residents in the fighting alongside the Syrian army which made it vulnerable to shelling that led to a number of victims and injuries.



#### Release

Syrian security services released the Palestinian refugee "Shehadeh Miari" from Neirab camp after being detained for more than six months. It is worth mentioning that Shehadeh was a member of the popular Committees at the beginning of arming these groups to protect the camp,

and then he retired under the pretext of deviation from the target of formation which is to protect the camp, and became fight alongside the regime against opposition groups.

The AGPS documented 83 detainees from Neirab camp in the Syrian regime's prisons, which is still reticent about their fate, and practiced all forms of torture on detainees according to the testimonies of released detainees.

#### Civil Work Committees

It was mentioned that Al Wafaa European convoy carried out relief campaigns for Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, Syria, and access to the besieged Palestinians in the Yarmouk refugee camp and nearby towns.



#### **Statistics**

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented the names of eight Palestinian refugees drowned while trying to immigrate to European countries in search of safety, security, and a decent life. The victims are:

Ali Hamid and his two wives, Zada Sheikh Khalil and Zahra Hindi from Alaedein camp in Homs, and were drowned off the Libyan coast, on Wednesday August 5.

Mohammed Swed from Neirab camp, died on August 9, 2015, after drowning in a lake in Germany.

The child "Osama Diab Majzoub" died on 8/20/2015 in the Mediterranean while trying to reach Europe.

Salam, Malak, and Bilal; children of the Palestinian refugee Ahmed Saleh Miari, who drowned as a result of boat that capsized off the Libyan shores on Thursday on 08/29/2015.


It is worth mentioning that the AGPS announced earlier that the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees who arrived to Europe during the past four years has exceeded 36,000.



#### Numbers and Statistics till 6/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 797 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 867 days, water was cut for 357 days

respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.

- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 659 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 860 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 504 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
