### *"International Prohibited Weapons Shell Civilians in Khan Al- Sheih"*



- "European Network for Palestinians of Syria" condemns targeting Khan Al-Sheih and demands to neutralize it and secure safe paths to deliver aids.

### ***Recent Updates***

*At Saturday night, Syrian and Russian aircrafts shelled Khan Al-Sheih and its outskirt with 4 airstrikes. Different parts of the camp were being targeted by at least 4 cluster bombs causing extensive material damages.*



*The camp and its outskirt are witnessing intensive airstrikes by all kinds of weapons including the international prohibited ones like cluster bombs. Those bombs consist of a mine dropped from high or medium distances then it spreads in the air as small bombs. Since they aren't precision-guided bombs, the possibility of targets' deviation will increase.*

*It should be mentioned that the heavy shelling which had targeted the camp in the last few days caused 26 victims and 120 injuries in the light of severe lack of medical equipment because of the strict siege on the camp imposed by regime's army.*

*In the same context, European Network for Palestinians of Syria condemns the last escalation against Khan Al- Sheih. It was targeted by a number of airstrikes using international prohibited weapons.*



*AGPS had received a copy from the network's press release that it deplores the crimes against 12000 PRS in the camp.*

*In addition to the severe lack of life necessities, medical services and infrastructure.*

*It demands in its press release all parties of the conflict to neutralize Palestinian camps especially Khan Al-sheih to avoid all these suffering and ramifications. It also calls UN and international institutions and committees, which care about human rights to interfere and secure a path to deliver aids, medicine, food and return basic and infrastructure services to the camps.*



*It's worth noting that the European Network office is in The Hague in Netherland, it contains a number of Palestinian- Syrian activists in Europe and it's interested about everything related to PRS in Europe.*

*Turning to another context, residents of Sabina camp still displaced from their homes since the fierce clashes between regime forces and armed opposition groups in 2012 which ended up with the control of regime forces on 17 November 2013.*

*Syrian regime promised camp residents to return them back after the rehabilitation of the infrastructure. Witnesses estimate the massive destruction inside the camp with more than 80% especially the extended*



area from "Muadh Ibn Jabal" mosque to the camp's oven (known as Kurds' Oven).

Since Syrian regime had controlled the camp, it keeps preventing Sabina residents from returning to the camp. According to UNRWA statistics in 2012, the camp population is (24298) people who are living in very difficult conditions after their displacement; lack of financial resources and unemployment turn their lives into a tragedy.

### **Civil Work Committees**

Jaфра institution has organized an entertaining day for Yarmouk's children in Yalda. A lot of entertaining and sport activities were held in that day in order to lessen the suffering of children in the town.

It should be noted that ISIS had controlled Yarmouk since the beginning of April 2015 and enforced hundreds of families to leave the camp to neighboring towns.







***Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 8/10/2016***

- *(15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.*
- *(42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *(6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.*
- *(8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.*
- *(1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.*
- *More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.*
- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1208) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1269) days. water was cut for (759) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1061) days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1253) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (911) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
