Victims


Mohammed Ahmed Al Hariri, a member of Al Sham Liberation Organization, died by an ISIS sniper in Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus. It is mentioned that ISIS was controlling the camp with support of the former Nusra Front, which supported ISIS against all the Military Syrian Opposition in the beginning of April 2015.

Recent Updates

The Turkish forces detained the Palestinians of Syria Mohammed Mahmoud Abu Talib,22 years, and Khalil Khalid Shaban, 25 years, while they were trying to cross to the Turkish territories illegally, they were detained in the foreigners' prison near the Syrian-Turkish boarders. The detained Abu Talib and Shabaan Launched a distress appeal to the PLO, the Palestinian Factions and the Palestine Embassy in Ankara to put pressure on the Turkish Government to work for their release and not returning them to Syria due to the danger to their life.

In a different context, the child Mousa Samer Amayri,16 years from Yarmouk camp, was missed 8 days ago while going from home in Daf Al Shouk area on Wednesday, 3 May 2017 to his work in Al Mahaba wal Salam Restaurant in Al Zahera area in Damascus, where no news about his destiny till the moment.



On the other hand, the Syrian Regime continues to detain the Palestinian refugee Maher Darwish" Abu Amed", in his thirties, from Al Aedin camp since 3rd of June 2015 because he didn't join the army forces in the fighting fronts against the Opposition forces. It is noted that Maher is a member of one of the Regimes affiliated groups and he is originally from Safad in Palestine. It is mentioned that the AGPS documented the names of 187 detainees in the Syrian prisons from the citizens of Al Aedin Camp in Homs, where the total amount of the Palestinian detainees in the Syrian prisons since the beginning of the war reached 1602 detainees, who are their fate is still unknown.

Khan Danun Camp citizens in Damascus suburb are haunted by the specter of the transportation crisis, where they become searching for a

solution for the crisis since the beginning of the war in Syra in 2011. The crisis in their view point is not just securing the transportation vehicles from and to the camp, which is located 23 Kilometer far from the south of Damascus. Transportation became one of the big problems for the citizens such as the drivers who exploit the citizens by raising the payment of the transportation according to their mood. The drivers also impose the plan of the journey, where the reach people to Al Koswa town and the people will be obliged to get more than one transportation means to reach their destinations, which adds a big financial burden on the citizens.

Khan Danoun citizens who delivered many complains earlier demanding all the concerning parties and the Palestinian factions and the governmental organizations to find an immediate solution to the crisis, which is negatively impacted the economic and living situation. The crisis also impact of preventing the students and employees to reach schools and universities. There is a complete scenario to keep the crisis due to the concerned parties silence and not interfering to put an end to the suffering of Khan Danun camp's citizens

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 09\05\2017

- The AGPS documented 3489 Palestinian victims, including 455 women.
- 1602 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 455 women.

- The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1391 consecutive days.
- 195 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.
- It is now more than 1122 days without water in Deraa camp, and 973 days in the Yarmouk camp.
- Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 146 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 200 days.
- Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.
