Recent Updates

In a statement published via internet, the UNRWA denounced what it called 'escalation of the armed conflict in Syria.' According to the statement, the 'armed conflict,' has led to the death of two Palestinians in Aleppo south of the country during the past days, in addition to the great threat of the lives of refugees in Khan Al Shieh camp.



The statement reported that UNRWA is still deeply concerned about the vulnerability of Palestine refugees and other civilians throughout Syria for the killing and seriously injured.

UNRWA reiterates its request to all parties to refrain exposing civilians to those risks; in order to protect the lives of civilians, it is necessary for all parties to respect and adhere to their stipulated obligations under international humanitarian law".

The AGPS correspondent reported that the regular army stationed at Talet Al Kabouseia targeted Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus western suburb with two shells, one of them landed in the eastern section and the other landed in the vicinity of Alrida mosque.

The shelling resulted in a slight injury in the head of an old man by the scattering of glass and shrapnel, and cause damage to property. The

Shilka tanks stationed at Al Salam highway opened fire on Khan Al Shieh western farms.

The regular army site on Talet Al Kabouseia in Damascus western suburb is considered as a nightmare for Palestinian refugee; the high location of the army make them completely overlooking the camp and other areas, making it vulnerable to be targeted by tank shells, mortars, and the anti-aircraft "Shilka".



The residents of the camp indicate that there is no are, house, or street was not targeted by the regular Army stationed at Talet Al Kabouseia, noting that the armed opposition groups tried more than once to target this military site, but they failed. The opposition groups managed to target tanks of the regular army, according to people in the region, while residents of the camp and the region, yet are observing two cannons, one tank, and a BMP vehicle, in addition to a number of soldiers.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS has documented the names of 163 victims of the Palestinian refugees in Khan Al Shieh camp; most of them died due to the shelling of aircrafts, tanks, artillery, and mortars stationed at Talet Al Kabouseia..

In the meantime, ISIS exploded a tunnel on the axis of Khamastaash Street near Alshatat square in the besieged Yarmouk refugee camp the day before yesterday. The explosion came after the Nusra discovered the tunnel, for fear of being used by the latter during battles with ISIS. Sporadic clashes often broke out in this street between Nusra and ISIS who seeks to completely extend its control over the street.

Witnesses from inside the camp reported that members of ISIS started digging tunnels among the residential buildings in areas controlled by Nusra and the Movement of Yarmouk people - Buraq Brigades, in preparation for exploding them. The two conflict parties continue digging people's homes, and open walls in the ongoing attempts to control the areas and residential buildings away from sniper fire.

Clashes between ISIS and Nusra continue for more than 70 days at most neighborhoods of the Yarmouk camp, which led to the killing and injury of a number of civilians. The clashes also prevented civilians of moving in order to bring their basic needs.



it is noteworthy that the Syrian Regime forces supported by Palestinian groups are besieging that Yarmouk camp for about 1089 consecutive

days, as they completely cut power for 1150 days, and water for 639 days. The forces prevent the entry of food and medicine, as well as they prevent the entry or exit of residents through the main entrance of the camp.

Civil Work Committees

The psychological support team of Jafra Foundation, south of the capital Damascus, implemented session to educate more than 400 displaced children from the Yarmouk camp about the risks that may face them. The team tries to search for talent and abilities of the children to try to develop them, as it works on entertainment through games, competitions, and awards in an attempt to alleviate their suffering.

Children and young Palestinian refugee exposed to gross violations of arrests carried out by the Syrian security forces, which led to the killing of dozens of victims who died due to starvation, lack of medical care, shelling, and sniping.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 9\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1090 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1151 days, water was cut for 640 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 944 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1135 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 797 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
