- ISIS Continues to Harass Residents of the Besieged Yarmouk Camp

Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent in Aleppo reported that the Palestinian refugee, Abeer Abidi, died with her fetus after she injured by shrapnel of mortars and rockets in Aleppo. The shelling targeted the Al Sakan Al Shababi building which is inhabited with a number of families who were displaced from Handarat camp. Her husband, Abdu Sweed and the young man, Ahmed Al Saadi were injured.

The shelling also targeted Al Furqan area in Aleppo, while the teacher, Ahmed Ali Jumaa, his wife, Sanaa Ali, and his daughter, Nour, from Nairab camp, were injured in the foot.



Meanwhile, violent shelling targeted Aleppo and some areas controlled by the Regime with many rockets yesterday by the armed opposition groups. The shelling resulted in 30 deaths and more than 140 injuries, in addition to severe material damages in civilian houses and properties.

Residents of Handarat camp were forced to leave their camp following violent clashes that broke out between the regime and the opposition

before about 1163 days. The clashes ended with the opposition's control over the camp.

The Syrian armed opposition forces prevented the return of residents since that period. Many residents are living at shelters such as the university campus in Aleppo, while others have displaced to other areas and camps.

News from the Yarmouk camp in Damascus reported that ISIS Continues to harass civilians, as they tried to impose the black Islamic dress for all women including those how are under 18 years.

Harassing civilians became unbearable, while ISIS members are interfering in personal freedoms in an abusive manner such as verbal abuse, beatings, and screaming in the faces of men and women, according to some residents".



A number of residents confirmed that ISIS prevents the people, who live in areas controlled by Nusra, to bring bread, water, and aid cartoons to their homes in the fighting areas. Several parties in the camp confirmed that ISIS continues to arrest dozens of Palestinian and Syrian civilians

from Yarmouk on charges of food entry to fighters from the Joulani - Nusra front.

On the other hand, hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families in Lebanon, Turkey, and Egypt are suffering of delayed procedures of family reunion in the Kingdom of Sweden. The procedures sometimes may up to more than 18 months, which doubles the psychological and physical pressure on those families, where the house rent in Turkey and Lebanon up to about (\$450) per month, in addition to the high cost of living, and lack of clarity of the legal status of those families, especially with respect to residency and freedom of movement.

The Swedish Immigration Service attributes delays with what they described as enormous pressure on them and their employees which leads to delayed reunion procedures of all refugees, including Palestinians of Syria.



For their part, many Palestinian Syrian refugees in Sweden confirmed that the delay comes within undeclared policy by the Swedish government aims to make Sweden as unwanted point for refugees, as part of several

actions taken by Sweden, including issuing restrict laws and legislation for asylum, such as to stop granting permanent residencies, and replace it with a period of 13 months, or (3) years.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 9\07\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1117 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1179 days, water was cut for 668 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 971 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 163 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 824 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
