#### Latest Developments

At least 14 Palestinian refugees were killed in war-ravaged Syria in June 2017, down from 36 in June 2016.

Daraa suburbs topped the list with 11 casualties. One refugee died in Damascus and another in AlRiqa. Another Palestinian died in an unknown location.

Among those killed in June 2016, 18 were pronounced dead in Rif Dimashq, six in Aleppo, and three in Damascus. Six Palestinians were killed in Deir AlZor, Daraa, and AlRiqa, with two casualties each.



Meanwhile, Yarmouk Camp has come under shelling for the third consecutive day.

Overnight on Saturday, the Syrian government forces and their war abettors struck Filastin Mosque, AlJou'ana neighborhood, among other adjacent areas, with mortar shells, resulting in heavy material damage.

A couple of days earlier, Jaysh AlIslam fighters attacked an ISIS site on the outskirts of AlZein neighborhood, adjacent to Yalda town, south of Yarmouk Camp.

In the meantime, the Syrian regime army on Sunday hit AlSadd Road, housing Palestinian families south of Syria, with a gas cylinder. Remarkable material damage was inflicted by the strike.

Several Palestinian families, mostly displaced from Daraa Camp, have sought shelter in AlBalad and AlSadd Road, where living conditions have taken a serious turn for the worse as a result of the raging warfare.

In another development, 150 patients displaced from Yarmouk to Yalda, Babila, and Beit Sahem received free medical check-ups at local clinics on the first day of the Sixth Medical Week launched by the Palestine Charity, in partnership with the Palestinian Red Crescent, south of Damascus.



The registered patients received medical checks, free medicines, and children's milk.

Civilians stranded in Yarmouk Camp, among other areas south of Damascus, have run out of life-saving medicines and medical kit due to the tough cordon imposed by the Syrian regime army and its war partners.

#### Palestinians of Syria: July 09, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,525 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,615 Palestinian refugees, including 101 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,446 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,182 and 1,033 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,526 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 260 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
