Victims

The 10-year-Palestinian girl, Nariman Issam Rustom, died and her father was injured after unknown group opened fire towards their car at Al Shiekh Saad town north of Deraa while heading to visit their relatives. They were displaced from Deraa town to Muzaireeb area in Deraa suburb.

The southern area of Syria is witnessing killings and assassinations implemented by unknown groups, in light of clashes and assassinations among the armed opposition groups and some pro-ISIS groups. The clashes resulted in a great displacement, especially at Sahem Golan, Heit, and Gillin, as the clashes affected hundreds of Palestinian refugees.

The Palestinian refugee, Ahmed Mohammed Nijma, died during clashes that broke out in the besieged Yarmouk camp south of the capital Damascus. He is a member of the military wing of the so-called 'Free Palestine Movement.'

it should be noted that some of the Palestinian factions and Syrian security branches have formed armed groups who are fighting against the armed opposition groups in several parts of Syria, and attracts dozens of young Palestinians to be sent to the battlefront.

Recent Updates

The death toll of torture victims of Palestinian refugees in the Syrian prisons, which is documented by the AGPS, rose to (445) victims since the beginning of the war in Syria. The AGPS documented (4) refugees who died since the beginning of this month, in addition to (17) refugees who died since the beginning of 2016. Meanwhile, (77) victims were recognized through the leaked images of the victims of torture.

Dozens of refugees died due to torture, while the Syrian security delivered their ID papers to their families who refuse to disclose their children's names for maintaining their residence within the regime controlled areas, and fearing the wrath of the Syrian security forces. Some released detainees confirmed the death of some Palestinian refugees without disclosing their names.



The AGPS documented (1077) Palestinian refugees who are detained in the Syrian prisons, including 61 women who are unaccounted for. Children, women, elderly, brothers, fathers, sons, entire families, and babies are detained in the prisons of the Syrian regime. According to the testimonies of some released detainees, the Palestinian refugees in the

Syrian security branches are exposed to all forms of torture and humiliation, from beatings and electric shocks and rape.

The AGPS called for the release of the Palestinian refugees who are detained in the regime's prisons and to reveal their fate, believing that what is happening in Syrian prisons is considered as a crime by all standards.

Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee implemented a summer club for the children of Muzaireeb town south of Syria, in an attempt to alleviate the psychological stress for those children who are suffering of scourge of war and harsh living conditions.



The summer club includes many recreational and cultural activities.

About (8500) Palestinian refugees are living in Muzaireeb town, in addition to hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from Deraa camp, are living in severe living conditions due to the repeated shelling, in addition to the non-arrival of any of the UNRWA aid

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 10\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1091 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1152 days, water was cut for 641 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 945 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 136 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 798 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
