Victims

The two PLA soldiers, Mufeed Majed Qadora and Mohammed Sweed, died during clashes that broke out between the Syrian armed opposition groups and the Regular Army alongside the PLA and the pro-regime popular committees.



The PLA military service is obligatory for the Palestinian refugees in Syria, which forces many youth, who refuse to join the military service during the ongoing war in Syria, to travel to neighboring towns.

The Palestinian refugee, Fouad Abu Hwaij, from Jaramana camp, died while fighting in Syria.

Dozens of Jaramana residents died while fighting alongside the Syrian regime against the armed opposition groups.

Recent Updates

The AGPS documented the arrest of 33 Palestinian refugees from Alsayeda Zainab camp since March 2011 till April 2016, in addition to 5 refugees who died inside the prisons of the Syrian regime due to torture.



The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented the information of 447 Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in the regime's prisons.



The AGPS statistics documented 1088 Palestinian detainees in the prisons of the Syrian regime. The number of detainees and torture victims is expected to be larger due to the lack of official statistics issued by the Syrian regime, in addition to the fear of detainees' families of revealing these cases for fear of the security bodies in Syria.

On the other hand, the AGPS correspondent in Damascus suburb reported that the Russian and the Syrian warplanes targeted Khan Al Shieh camp and its outskirts on Sunday with more than 6 explosive barrels. 3 explosive barrels were dropped at civilians' houses at Al Saed Street and resulted in severe destruction.





The Russian warplanes implemented 3 raids against Khan Al Shieh-Zakia road, noting that it is the only road that supplies the camp with essential materials and food. All roads are still closed, forcing the residents to go through Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road despite the high risk.

The suffering of residents is increasing after the regular army checkpoints' prevention of civilians and car to pass, which exacerbated the living crises, especially with regards to the medical services, in addition to the continuous targeting and deaths among the Palestinian refugees.

The Palestinian refugee, Abed Ghanim, from Nairab camp in Aleppo south of Syria, died during the ongoing clashes in the vicinity of Handarat camp between the Regular army alongside Alquds brigades and the armed opposition groups. He is a member of the pro-regime Alquds brigades.



The Pro-regime Alquds brigades lost more than 100 fighters during the last battles at Handarat camp, including Palestinian refugees from Nairab and Handarat camps, in addition to hundreds of wounded.



The AGPS documented 753 victims among the Palestinian refugees who died by gunshot since the beginning of war events.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 10\07\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1118 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1180 days, water was cut for 669 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 972 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 164 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 825 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
