“An Opposition Military Group Executes Palestinian Refugees in the Yarmouk camp under the Charge of Cursing the Name of God”



- Five Palestinian refugees were killed in the Yarmouk camp.
- Bombing targets the Yarmouk camp in Damascus.
- For 425 days, the Regular Army prevents the residents of Al Husayneyya camp to return to their houses.
- A Group of volunteers celebrate the World Child Day with Al Nairab camp children.
- The Palestine Charity Commission cleans the streets of the Yarmouk camp.
- The Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon are suffering of bad living conditions in light of UNRWA Services systematic minimization.

Victims

A group of the Al Nusra front from the military Opposition executed the Palestinian refugees Mari Al Madani, A PLA first-sergeant dissenter, and Mohammed Abu Seyyam from Al Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in south of Damascus under the charge of cursing the name of God. The bombing on the Yarmouk camp led to the death of two female sisters children Dina Naser 9 years old and Maryem Naser 4 years old. The PFGC announced the death of Ehab Anwar Abbas , PFGC member, due to the clashes in the Yarmouk camp between the Syrian Opposition and the Regular army with it military Group the PFGC.

Statistics

According to the statistics of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, the number of the Palestinian victims inside Syria till the end of October 2014 is 2494 victims, where in Damascus the number of victims is 1116 refugees, 679 victims in Damascus Suburb, 274 victims in Dar'aa camp, 162 victims in Aleppo, 57 victims in separate and different boarder areas, 88 victims in Homs, 34 victims in Hamaa, 32 victims in Latheqia, 30 victims in Al Qunitera, 19 victims from the Palestinian refugees camps in Aleppo where most of them are from Idlib while they were doing their compulsory service at the PLA, they were executed in a horrible massacre in 11\7\2012, and 3 victims in Al Swayda.



Recent Updates

A group of the Al Nusra front from the military Opposition executed the Palestinian refugees Mari Al Madani A PLA first-sergeant dissenter and Mohammed Abu Seyyam from Al Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in south of Damascus under the charge of cursing the name of God. The bomb in the camp led to the death of two female children, who are sisters, Dina Naser 9 years old and Maryem Naser 4 years old and a number of wounded amongst civilians.

In the same context, a number of mortar shells hit the vicinity of the Yarmouk Municipality without reporting about any casualty, coincided with violent clashes between the Opposition, the Regular Army and the PFGC inside the camp which led to the death of Ehab Anwar Abbas , PFGC member. The Yarmouk camp siege which is imposed by the Regular Army and the PFGC , continues for more than 523 days and 157 refugee victims due to the shortage of nourishment and medical care.

On the other hand, the residents of Al Husayneyya camp are suffering of displacement between shelter centers and rent houses after they were obliged to leave their houses due to the violent battles between the Regular Army and military Opposition Groups, despite the control of the Regular Army over the camp but it still prevents the residents to return back to their houses since about 425 days.



The National Basma Youth Group at Al Nairab performed a round on the schools of Al Nairab where they presented some artistic programs for the children of the camp in the occasion of World Child Day. It is mentioned that the location of the camp which surrounds the Al Nairab Airport made the camp a center for several clashes points between the Regular Army and the Syrian Opposition Groups.

Civil Society Committees

The Palestine Charity Commission Services Department performed a campaign to clean some neighborhoods in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian Refugees in Damascus, where it seeks to minimize the impact of the strict siege that is imposed on the camp from the Regular Army and PFGC since about a year and half.

Lebanon

The Lebanese government performs procedures that are minimizing the number of the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon and it also imposes strict procedures to accept any refugee in its lands. A human rights activist insured that there is an official decision to minimize the number of refugees and to tighten the acceptance of any Palestinian refugee to Lebanon but under serious exceptional conditions. It is



referred that the number of displaced Palestinian refugees from Syria to Lebanon is between 44000 and 45000 Palestinian refugees.

The Displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon are suffering of difficult living, economic and social situation especially in the winter season which reveal the problems of the refugees such as food, housing and clothing. All this comes after the UNRWA excluded a big number of refugees from its winter aids that are given to the Palestinians of Syria and the UNRWA distributed its winter aids on the most cold areas such as Al Beqaa'. In the same context, the UNRWA continues to cut the financial aids on more than 1100 Palestinian refugee families from Syria.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 11/12/2014

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **523** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **604** days, water was cut for **93** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **157** victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **425** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **395** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **595** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **240** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - Power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
