Latest Developments

On the International Human Rights Day, AGPS revealed its documentation of its great physical violations against the Palestinian refugees from Syria. The Group said that to this day, it has recorded that 5258 Palestinians have been subjected to physical violations, amid the ongoing violence in Syria, in addition to the thousands of injuries resulting from various reasons since the beginning of war.



The Documentation Team noted that 475 refugees died under the torture of members of the Syrian security and its affiliated groups, including women, children and elderly people. In the meantime, the security handed dozens of the victims of torture's families their children's personal papers. The parents however, refused to reveal their names, fearing the wrath of the members of the Syrian security.

The testimonies of the released detainees have confirmed the death of Palestinian refugees, without mentioning their names.

The Documentation Team clarified that the Syrian regime continues to forcibly hide more than 1644 in the prisons and security branches, of which 106 are females. They are all subjected to all kinds of torture inside the Syrian security branches and the secret and public detention centers without the slightest forms of health care and in very difficult humanitarian circumstances, leading to the death of hundreds of detainees.

In south Damascus, violent clashes broke out yesterday, between the Syrian regime forces and its affiliated groups, and 'Hayat Tahrir Al-Sham' organization in Yarmouk camp.

On its part, media sources close to 'Tahrir Al-Sham,' said that the group foiled the regime's forces' attempt to storm into Yarmouk camp, from the Sufian Al-Thawri barracks, close to Road 30. The area is under the Al-Fouah and Kafria Agreement between the regime and the group.

Violent clashes between the groups affiliated to the regime and ISIS in Al-Shohadaa sector, in Yarmouk camp, causing destruction to the residents' houses.

In another context, the Palestinian refugees continued their participation in rallies and protests in the Palestinian camps and areas of presence, against Trump's decision. In Lebanon, a number of Yarmouk camp's residents got injured by the gas bombs thrown

by the Lebanese police, during an attempt to break into the American embassy in Beirut.



In Syria, protests and stands went out in the cities of Azaz, Jarabulus and Mare' in Aleppo, north of Syria, and in a number of camps, to condemn Trump's decision. Hundreds of Palestinian refugees and residents of the region participated.

In Europe, thousands of Palestinian refugees from Syria and other countries, protested in a number of European cities, to condemn the decision to transfer the American embassy.

In the meantime, the Community Development and Empowerment Team in the Charitable Association for Palestinian Relief, in cooperation with the Psychological Support Team in the Palestinian Red Crescent organized an entertaining carnival and psychological support for Palestinian children in the Jaffa Center for Social Development, in the town of Qudsaya, in the suburbs of Damascus.

One of the members of the Association, clarified that the activity comes as part of a series of recreational activities, in support of

alleviating the psychological and social negative effects on children and contributes to the participation and the achievement of joy. The activity included a lunch for children who are sponsored by the social welfare program and their families.



In Dubai, the Palestinian bodybuilder, “Shady Ahmed,” participated in the Masl Show competition, which was held on the 9th of December in Dubai. The competition included professional bodybuilders from all over the world.

About the importance of participating in the competition, Shady Ahmed from Yarmouk camp his aim for participating, is to win the championship and raise the flag of Palestine in the sports events and international forums, and to prove to the world that the Palestinians in general, and the Palestinians of Syria in particular, no matter what calamities and tragedies come upon us, we can rise again and rebuild ourselves and our future.

Ahmed noted that despite not achieving an advanced position in this tournament, because of the lack of support from any Palestinian sports institution, his participation served as a catalyst for him and the beginning of the road to professionalism. He added that he is

keen to continue his practicing, preparation and development of himself, in order to win the Masl Show competition, to compete against the world champions, with hope to obtain a card to qualify him to reach competitions at the world level.

Palestinians of Syria: December 10, 2017 Statistics:

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3615, including 463 women
- 1644 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 106 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,607 days in a row
- 204 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1344 days, and 1184 days in Yarmouk Camp
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo have been banned from their homes for 1,680 days. Government troops have taken over the camp for more than 443 days.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
