Statistics

The AGPS Documentation and monitoring team announced that the number of Palestinians of Syria victims, who died due to sniping since the beginning of the events in Syria, is 268 victims, where the AGPS insures that 10 victims died by snipers shots in the second half of 2014. The AGPS also clarified that the number of Palestinians of Syria who died due to the ongoing war in Syria is 2644 victims.

Victims

Two conscripts of the PLA died during the ongoing war in Syria; they are, Mohammed Saif Al Dien and Husam Sweed 20 years, raising the victims toll to 105 that were documented by the AGPS, most of them died due to military works in Damascus Suburb. It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinian youth refuse to serve in the obligatory army service for fear of being involved in the ongoing conflict in Syria, where most of them were obliged to leave Syria for fear of being arrest.

Recent Updates

The tragedy of the Yarmouk camp in south of Damascus continues increasing due to the continuation of the siege that is imposed on the camp by the Regular Army and its Palestinian Groups for about 584 days, where the power cut continues for more than 664 days, water cut continues since about 154 days.

In terms of the negotiations of ending the Diaspora capital siege, the implementations inaction controls the initiatives amid recriminations. In the same context, Feisel Al Meqda, the Syrian Foreign Affairs Minister, said that the Syrian Government is ready to overcome the obstacles to reach the aids to the Yarmouk camp in order to alleviate the suffering of the residents. This declaration came during the minister meeting yesterday with Anwar Abdel Hadi, The PLO Political Dept. Director, in the Syrian Ministry in Damascus city, the two parties discussed the situation of the Palestinian camps in Syria and insured to work to reach

the food aids to the Yarmouk residents immediately whatever the conditions are, according to websites affiliated to the Syrian Regime.

Al Wafedeen camp was exposed to bombing with a number of mortar shells that targeted separate areas of the camp caused only material damages. It is referred that the camp, which includes a number of Palestinian refugees and displaced Syrians, suffers from poverty and high rate of unemployment due to the difficult living situation even before the Syrian conflict.

On a different context, the Regular Army and the Syrian Security carried out arrest and investigation campaigns with the Palestinians of Syria from the residents of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus City, where the

Regular Army Kokab checkpoint members arrested Abdallah Sanad "Abu Yazan" yesterday. Yousef Abu Hamam and Abdullah Abu Easa were arrested at Al Kobri checkpoint at Al Keswa and they are bus drivers, moreover, they arrested two of the camps residents for couple of hours then they released them. In the same context, the Syrian Army and Security forces released the residents who were arrested from the bus the day before, while they kept the driver and another passenger. It is referred that all roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas are closed except for Zakia-Khan Al Sheih road.

The Muzareeb town residents in Dar'aa governorate live in tension and instability state due to targeting the town with explosive barrels and bomb cars that led to the death of many people from Al Muzareeb town. It is noted that the number of Palestinian refugees at Al Muzareeb town is 8000 refugees. On 10th of February 2014, Al Muzareeb town was exposed to a huge explosion due to targeting the camp with explosive barrels by warplanes near Tara'an UNRWA School, which led to the injury of about 40 students in addition to four school employees. On 18th of February 2014, A horrible massacre was committed at Al Muzareeb compound due to explosive barrels that targeted Ein Al Zaytoun UNRWA school and the UNRWA clinic while the students were inside the school, which led to more than 15 Palestinian victims.

Al Nairab camp for Palestinian Refugees in Aleppo witnessed instability and unsafe state due to the deteriorated security situation in the surrounding areas and the participation of some of its residents in the fighting alongside the Syrian Army, however, this exposed the camp to targeting with a number of shells on separate places that led to a number of wounded and victims. The suffering of Al Nairab residents continues increasing specially the high prices, the merchants' greediness and the severe shortage of food and medicines in light of the unavailability of the financial resources and the unemployment spread as a reflection to the ongoing conflict in Syria.

In Al Aedin camp for Palestinian refugees in Hama, a state of quietness prevailed in the camp where it is considered relatively quiet compared to other Palestinian camps that witnessed continuous bombing and siege, but this doesn't let the camp far from the consequences of the ongoing war in Syria. The unemployment is spread amongst Al Aedin camp residents, most of them lost their work due to the security tensions inside

the camp that led double the economic crises in the camp, thus, the camp residents suffer of the power cut and high prices which prompted many of them to migrate out of Syria. The AGPS documented 25 victims from Al Aedin camp in Hama and 42 detainees in the Syrian prisons, 2 victims died due to torture and a refugee was executed in the field by the Syrian Army forces.

Civil Work Committees

In Yarmouk Camp, Jafra Organization started protection and treatment campaigns against the Jaundice disease for the students of Alternative schools, where Jafra visited Al Amal primary school and they made a medical check to the students, in addition, they gave the infected people with Jaundice disease a can of jam and explained the way of treatment through it. Medical resources at the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian Refugees in Syria mentioned that it recorded more than 105 infected cases with jaundice amongst women, children and old people in the camp due to the malnutrition and the lack of medical care and hygiene.

The medical teams warned earlier from a humanitarian disaster that affects the residents of the Yarmouk camp specially women, children and old men due to the continues siege that is imposed by the Regular Army and its groups, which prevents the entry of medical and food materials to the camp.

The Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian People received about 1200 food baskets after preparing them with food items in order to

be distributed on the residents of Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb, the charity commission distributed the food cards from the Commission statistics department in order to ease the distribution process. It is referred that the residents of Khan Danoun camp suffer of clear lack of relief activities in light of the difficult situation that they live in due to the unavailability of charity societies or local committees because of the security tightening and the arrest campaigns that targeted several relief activist by the Syrian Regime forces, which led the committees to close in order to save its activists lives. Khan Danoun is considered the poorest amongst the Palestinian camps in Syria where they depend on the financial and relief aids of UNRWA once in a while. Moreover, the residents complain from the sever living crises such as the shortage of food materials, unemployment spread and poverty in addition to the continuation of power, water and telecommunications for long periods.

Egypt

The detained Palestinians of Syria refugees in Egypt, who are poisoned in Karmouz prison in Alexandria in inhumane conditions since 100 days, continues their hunger strike for the second day respectively claiming to

achieve their demands that are represented in the immediate coordination among the concerned parties for receiving them in the European countries specially the countries that have their family members.

Numbers and Statistics till 10/2/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- 2642 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 584 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 663 days, water was cut for 154 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 165 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 486 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 455 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 657 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 301 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
