RECENT UPDATES

The rest of residents inside Daraa camp Complain about of the lack of any hospital or medical care inside the camp, and the acute shortage of medicines and materials of first aid and medical equipment, in addition to the lack of ambulances to transport the injuries to receive medical treatment outside the camp. Jordanian Authorities refuse entry of any Palestinian refugees from Syria even the injuries.



Regarding this deteriorating health situation; activists from inside the camp, warned of the spread of disease among the people, as residents have to use contaminated drinking water, since the running water has been cut for (599) days.

In a different context; pro-regime websites reported current preparations to form a new Palestinian military faction called the "Sons of Yarmouk" to be spread out over the camp, while the AGPS could not ensure the authenticity of this news.

According to those sources, the new faction includes Palestinian militants from the Yarmouk camp whether from those who are still live inside the camp, or from the displaced families, pointing out that the new faction is planning to spread out within the camp in accordance with the Syrian armed opposition and the Syrian regime.

It should be noted that there are conflicting information about evacuating ISIS' forces from the Yarmouk camp which controls it since last April, while no official statement was issued from the Syrian government or ISIS so far.

In Lebanon; dozens of Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria had organized a sit-in front of the Canadian embassy in Beirut to demand legal immigration, as a result of living, legal and economic miserable conditions they are suffering from.



The refugees delivered a message to the Canadian Embassy in which they expressed their desire to immigrate after they lost all their possessions in Syria due to the ongoing conflict, and about their deteriorating living

conditions in Lebanon which pushed many of them towards irregular migration and riding the death sea boats.

According to the protesters, the (UNHCR) and the Western embassies should allow the Palestinian refugees to immigrate legally after the Lebanese government "closed all the doors in front of them" and led them to such conditions.

In a different context the Committee of the Palestinians-Syrians in Lebanon, in cooperation with the Al-Quds charity distributed winter clothes to families in Al-Baddawi camp near Tripoli in northern Lebanon.

It is worth mentioning that the number of Palestinian-Syrians who live in Al-Beddawi camp estimated at (850) family out of (42.5) thousand in Lebanon, which recently, unofficial statistics pointed out a decrease in this number to 33 thousand.

STATISTICS

Statistics of the AGPS pointed that 37.30% of the Palestinian victims during the second half of 2015 were from the military, (66) Palestinian victims were killed during the fight between the regime and the armed opposition as follows: (59) pro-regime victims and (8) pro-opposition victims.

The monitoring and documentation team in the AGPS mentioned the following details: (7) of the refugees were killed while fighting alongside the Syrian armed opposition forces, (19) refugees were killed during fighting alongside the Syrian regime, (13) victims belong to the PFLP-

GC, (16) are conscripted in Palestinian Liberation Army PLA, (9) others belong to Al-Quds Brigade, and two from Fatah al-Intifada movement.

The AGPS has documented more than (3097) Palestinian-Syrians who were killed during the war in Syria so far.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and Statistics until 11 January 2016

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 923 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 983 days, water cut for 483 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 919 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 984 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 637 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
