Victims

The three Palestinian refugees "Ahmed Hamdan," "Mohammed Amayri," and "Mohammed Ali" died due clashes broke out yesterday between ISIS and Al Nusra Front in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus.



Recent Updates

Clashes between ISIS and Nusra have been ongoing for 5 consecutive days in the Yarmouk camp. Three Palestinian refugees died during these clashes; they are: Ahmed Hamdan, Mohammed Amayri, and Mohammed Ali. Our correspondent confirmed a number of deaths among the two parties of conflict, in addition to a number of houses were burnt at Haifa Street because of the usage of Molotov bombs during the clashes yesterday.

On the other hand, dozens of families are still besieged inside their houses at Haifa Street, Khamastaash Street, Al Shatat Area, Alquds Mosque area, and Al Madares Street. The families are suffering of severe

dire living situation due to the scarcity of food, medication, and water. They also demanded previously roads to be open and secure in order to obtain water.

Meanwhile, our correspondent reported that areas controlled by ISIS extend from Al Hajar al Aswad area to Al Orouba area, Palestine hospital area, Amer car repair shop, Dier Yaseen neighborhood, Al Madares Street, the vicinity of Palestine mosque, a large part of Khamastaash Street, a part of Safoureya Street, Al Basil hospital, along Safad Street towards Palestine mosque, in addition to Al Shuhadaa district from Al Khayam institute till Salah Al Dein Al Ayoubi mosque.



However, areas controlled by Al Nusra inside the camp limit to Al Jaouna neighborhood, specifically from the Democratic front office till Palestine square, Al Tarboush area at Palestine Street, Haifa Street, Al Malkeya School, the vicinity of Al Waseem mosque towards Khamastaash Street and Al Rija square, as its snipers center at both sides of Loubiea Street.

Our correspondent added that the snipers also center at both sides of the Yarmouk and Safad Streets in some cases. He also noted that the clashes

are still ongoing and the field situation is constantly changing. In southern Syria, a number of mortar shells targeted different areas of Deraa camp for Palestinian refugees this morning; there were no reports of damage so far.

People of the camp are still suffering due to the absence of health and relief services, where they did not receive any aid for more than two years. It is worth mentioning that 70% of the camp's buildings were completely and partially damaged due to the repeated bombing which targeted the camp with most types of missiles and explosive barrels. On the other hand, activists and family of the Palestinian refugee "Walid Abu Raya," who is detained in the Syrian regime's prisons, appealed the Palestinian factions, the Palestinian Ambassador, and the General Authority for Refugees to intervene to reveal his destiny and to ensure his return to his family unharmed.

This appeal came after he was arrest at one of the regime's checkpoints

at Al Kiswa area in Damascus suburb on 2015-11-26 while he was leaving the capital Damascus for treatment after he was injured in the head while fixing an electrical fault in Khan Al Shieh camp. He is one of the volunteers in the electricity reform team at Khan



Al Shieh camp; he is married with three children.

1068 Palestinian prisoners in the Syrian regime's prisons are still unaccounted for, including 108 detainees from Khan Al Shieh camp, who mostly were arrested at the Syrian regime checkpoints, especially Koukab checkpoint, in Sehnaya, Jadedat Artouz, and entrances of Khan Camp.

Palestinian militants accused the Syrian security services of following the systematic displacement policy against people of Al Aedein camp for Palestinian refugees in Homs, through raids and inspections of homes and arrests carried out by the Syrian security detachment of the camp especially at Al Quds Street and the vegetable market. Young Palestinian targeted for and Syrian people are army Forcing a large number of young people to stay at homes and stop going to universities and institutes so as the security members not to tear their military postponement paper and led them to the military services, as happened with some students despite they paid the tuition fees, especially for open education, which grants them a systematic army services postponement for study.

Meanwhile, activists confirmed that almost daily a family or a resident leaves his house and displaces from the camp towards Turkey and the European countries, while there are a large number of youth and families in Turkey are waiting to be able to reach the European lands legally or illegally.

On 21st of June 2015, the Syrian authorities built an iron fence that separates the neighborhoods of Al Aedein camp in Homes and the adjacent other neighborhoods, without any service corridors between the

two sides in order to tighten the control over the camp's residents, and to monitor their movement in and outside of the camp, especially the youth.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS has documented 186 Palestinian prisoners from Al Aedein camp are still unaccounted for, while it documented the death of a number of residents due to torture in the Syrian prisons.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 11\04\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1031 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1092 days, water was cut for 581 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 886 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1079 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.

- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 739 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
