"Two Palestinian Refugees Died due to an Explosion at Al Sayeda Zainab Neighborhood in Damascus Suburb"



- A Resident of Jaramana Camp Died while Fighting Alongside the Syrian Regime Forces
- Thousands of Palestinian Refugees Besieged in the Yarmouk Camp are Suffering of Lack of Medical Services
- The Syrian Security Releases the Palestinian Refugee, Fahed Hayatli from Al Aedein Camp in Homs

Victims

Activists confirmed to the AGPS that the two refugees, Mohammed Hasan Tayem and Taha Ahmed Sharqi, from Al Sayeda Zainab camp, died due to the explosion that targeted Al Sayeda Zainab neighborhood in Damascus suburb this morning.

The explosion resulted in tens of deaths and injuries, while the total number is not known yet.



The young man, Alaa Ali Sayah, from Jaramana camp in Damascus suburb, died while participating in the ongoing conflict in Syria. Tens of residents from Jaramana camp have died while participating in the fighting alongside the Syrian regime against the armed opposition groups.

Recent Updates

The remaining residents of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, who are estimated with 3000-5000 civilians, are suffering of severe shortage of



medical services due to the strict siege imposed by the regular army and the PFGC groups for 1090 days. They also suffer from the continuous shelling that targets the main hospitals of the camp, which led to severe damages that led to the suspension of its work.

Meanwhile, the control of ISIS over the camp, since the beginning of last April, has exacerbated these conditions, while most relief bodies were forced to leave the camp towards Yalda town following assassinations of many activities by ISIS.

187 Palestinian refugees have died due to the siege as a result of the lack of nutrition and the medical care.



The Syrian security released the Palestinian refugee, Fahed Hayatli, from Al Aedein camp in Homs, after being detained for about 5 months, while 186 Palestinians are still detained, according to the statistics of the AGPS. The detainees are still unaccounted for, while a large number have died due to torture.



It is worth mentioning that the residents of Al Aedein camp in Homs are suffering of great harassments by the Syrian security detachment's members, who implement arrest and raid campaigns every now and then, as they inspect the IDs of the passers and impose royalties, which forces the residents to migrate outside the country.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 11\06\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1092 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1153 days, water was cut for 642 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 946 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 137 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 798 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
