Recent Updates

Despite the deteriorated living situation suffered by the Palestinian residents of Yarmouk camp in Damascus from frequent bombing and continuous siege since around (683) days, and despite the deterioration of the situation after ISIS storming to Yarmouk, those things together could not break the will of the children of the camp. Al JArmaq alternative School carried out yesterday a ceremony in honor of the students on the occasion of the end of the school year.

For their part, parents of children confirmed their adherence to stay inside the camp, refusing all invitations which aims to get them out of their homes. In the same time, they call on all international, humanitarian, and Palestinian organizations to work in order to end the siege, and to neutralize the refugees from the conflict in Syria.

Turning to Damascus, the Palestinian refugees in Sbeina, Husseneia, and AL Theiabeia renewed their demand to open a way for their return to their homes after the regular army and some Palestinian groups continued to prevent them from returning to their homes.

The Palestinian refugees in Sbeina camp have been forced to leave the camp 545 days ago, because of the violent clashes that broke out between the regular army and armed groups of the opposition, which ended with the regular army control on the camp and completely destroyed nearly 80% of its buildings.

In Husseneia camp, Syrian regular army continues to prevent residents, and delay their return to their homes for 564 days respectively, although they fully control the camp since 17th of October2013. The checkpoints of the regular army close the entrances of the camp and to prevent the families from returning to it.

It is noteworthy that the Syrian government has promised several times to open a way for the return of the residents of these areas, but they were unsuccessful, and as subjected to a flow of criticism even from within the government for the lack of justification of the continued closure of Husseineia, Sbeina, and Altheiabeia.

On the other hand, people of Al Aedein camp in Homs complain from continuing warplanes hovering at low altitude in the sky of the camp, where powerful sound caused a state of terror among the children of the camp.

It is worth mentioning that warplanes continuously hovering about two months ago, and raided the neighboring areas of the camp.

The young man, "Aladdin Ahmed Fares" in his thirties, from Al Aedein camp in Homs, was arrested since 13-April, during a raid on a Syrian security offices in the adjacent neighborhood of Al Shmas.

Numbers and Statistics till 11/5/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 683 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 753 days, water was cut for 243 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 564 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 545 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 747 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 390 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
