"Palestinian Boy from Daraa Camp Killed at the Turkish Borders"

VICTIMS

The PRS boy "Yazan Ghazi Bilal" 15-years-old resident of Dara camp, was killed at the Turkish borders while trying to pass from ISIL-controlled region of Dodia, next to Izaz, towards the Turkish territories. It is noteworthy that Turkish borders witness a high-level alert by border guards and Turkish Army which spreads out along the line.

It is worth mentioning that four Palestinians were killed recently while trying to pass through the Kurd-controlled regions towards Turkey, meantime, hundreds of other families are still waiting a chance to pass.



RECENT UPDATES

The Palestinian refugees in south of Syria, in Dara camp, Jillin, Al-Muzireeb, and other towns complain about the poor medical services, due to the lack of medical supplies and severe shortage of medicines caused by the war conditions as well as the weakness of opposition forces running the region's affairs.

Activists said such situations on the ground is mainly caused by the siege imposed by regime's forces as well as by its military troops which fires

shells non-stop and targets hospitals and clinics, not forgetting the migration of medical cadres.




Many activists warned of the possible spread of diseases in light of drinking water cut for 710 days.

In a different topic, sporadic clashes occurred last night at Al-Yarmouk camp near the contact points between the opposition and regime's forces, accompanied by sounds of explosions.

This comes while the siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp continues for the day 1001 non-stop, all roads are still closed, power supply still off for 1062 days, and water cut for 551 days, all kinds of food and fuel are entry prohibited, while total number of siege victims reached 186.

The monitoring and documentation team of AGPS assured documenting 3183 PRS victims killed in Syria since the start of the war, 1062 killed by shelling, 714 killed by clashes, and 436 tortured to death in regime's prisons.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 12 March 2016

- 15,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan,
- 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 1001 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1055 days, water cut for 551 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 857 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1050 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 712 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.
