The AGPS documentation and monitoring team insured that it documented 4500 Palestinian detainees in the Syrian Prisons. The documentation was through the documentation campaign that was launched by the AGPS to collect the Palestinian detainees' names in Syria for the last three months.

The AGPS Correspondent in South of Damascus reported that the Syrian Army released the Palestinian female with other 3 women in an exchange agreement between the Islam Army, one of the armed opposition groups, and the Syrian Army.

In details, on Thursday a prisoners' exchange agreement was implemented at Bebla-Sedi Jaber checkpoint. The agreement included hat the Islam Army releases a man and his wife, who were accused of collaborators with the Syrian Army, and the Syrian will release 6 detainees. 44 women were released and the Syrian regime will also release 2 men in the coming days. One of the mediators said that 3 of the freed women are from Yelda and they were detained for more than 4 months, where the fourth woman was being detained for a year and she is a Palestinian refugee from Yarmouk Camp. The Islam Army didn't announce the names of the released detainees. It was mentioned that there was a condition of releasing women who were being arrested since along time ad due to revolutionary reasons not criminal reasons and from anywhere in Syria.

The Islam Army south of Damascus announced that the collaborator man is a member of the Palestinian militias that are affiliated to the Syrian regime. He was arrested a year and a half ago, where he was entering poisonous sera and his wife was helping him in addition to smuggling silencers of guns to the area.

It is mentioned that the Syrian Armed groups were able to liberate a number of Palestinian refugee women in prisoners' exchange agreements with the Syrian regime, where the Syrian regime continues to detain more than 100 Palestinian refugee women since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria. It is mentioned that no camp of the Palestinian refugee camps in Syria that doesn't have a woman detainee among its citizens.

The AGPS correspondent in South Damascus reported that the Elementary students, from the displaced people of Yarmouk camp in the surrounding towns, left to Damascus for performing their efficiency exams. The correspondent continued that 1755 of the students and supervisors could leave through Bit Shem south of Damascus to Alyans center to stay till the end of their exams and their leave was under the supervision of UNRWA and the Public Refugees Commission in Damascus. It is referred that the educational process in south of Damascus didn't stop in spite of all obstacles that face the residents of the camp, where the students leave the southern area after coordination and approval of the Syrian Security forces.

#### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 12\05\2017

- The AGPS documented 3495 Palestinian victims, including 455 women.
- 1602 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 87 women.
- The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1394 consecutive days.
- 195 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.
- It is now more than 1125 days without water in Deraa camp, and 976 days in the Yarmouk camp.
- Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 1469 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 203 days.
- Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.
