"The AGPS: the Torture Victims' Toll rises to 301, and the Number is expected to Increase"

Victims

The documentation and monitoring team of the AGPS announced that the Number of torture victims in the Syrian Regime prisons increased to 301 documented Palestinian victims. The raise came after the death of each of the young man "Mahmoud Mohammed Mawed" and the refugee "Tariq Mawed"; they are from the Yarmouk camp and died due to torture in the Regime prisons. The refugee "Tariq Mawaed" was arrested from the (DTC) Damascus Training Center of UNRWA at AL Maza area in Damascus, and the refugee "Mohammed Khalid Fouad Abu Abeid," 26 years, also died due to torture after being missed on 10-11-2012.

The victims were identified through leaked pictures for the torture victims who died due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons, while the AGPS confirms that the number is expected to increase as a result of torture and deteriorated conditions that face at least 784 Palestinian detained refugees at the Syrian regime prisons.

Recent Updates

A number of residents and activists from the Yarmouk camp called for demonstration on Friday in order to demand the release of the Palestinian Syrian refugees who are detained by the Syrian security. This call came after the Syrian Security members arrested the Palestinian refugee "Mahmoud Tameim" from the Yarmouk camp at the aid distribution point, while some activists inside the camp appealed the

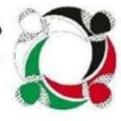
In a related context, the distribution of some urgent relief aid was resumed yesterday to be distributed to the besieged residents of the Yarmouk camp which is tightly besieged by the Regular Army and PFGC groups for about 614 days respectively.

In Damascus suburb, a medical resource from inside Jaramana camp announced the emergence of some Hepatitis C cases among the residents amid fears of the disease to be spread amongst the residents, especially the school students and the shelter center residents.

It is mentioned that Jaramana camp formed a destination to hundreds of Palestinian families who fled their camps due to shelling and siege.

In Homs, the Syrian security forces arrested two Palestinian refugees from Al Aeden camp in Homs; they are: the young man "Ghasan Ahmed Al Ghadban," in his thirties, originally from Safad city in Palestine, as he was arrested on 7-3-2015, and the young man "Mustafa Al Rouba," in his twenties, originally from Safad city in Palestine, and he was arrested on 9-3-2015.

On the other hand, a delegation of the Palestinian House Association members in Netherlands organized a visit to the tow asylum centers of katwijkand Diunrell on Wednesday 11th of March. The visit came in order to inspect the conditions of the Palestinians of Syria refugees and to provide them with help, Legal Consultations, and advises.

It is worth mentioning that at least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 614 days respectively. In addition, power cuts

continued for more than **694** days, water was cut for **184** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to **172** victims.

- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 516 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 485 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 687 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 331 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
