Victims

Three Palestinian refugees were killed, yesterday, in Syria. Adel Saleh Awwad from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo was killed under torture in the Syrian security prisons after being arrested for about six months.

Ahmed Mohammed Hasan and Mohammed Saleim AL Natour, Palestinian refugees from Aleppo and members of Al Quds brigade of the Syrian Army were killed after clashes between them and groups belonging to the Free Army in Al Zahra neighborhood at Aleppo.

Recent Updates

Resuming the distribution of limited amounts of aid, yesterday afternoon, which is presented from UNRWA agency to the residents of the Yarmouk refugee camp under the continuation of the strict siege imposed for about a year.

Regular Army and groups of Popular Front-General Command prevented the entry of food and basic supplies, what aggravate the health and living situations inside the camp.

Meanwhile, the Action Group has documented 151 victims who were died because of the hunger and the lack of health care.

Lebanon

Palestinian Syrian refugees, who were forced to leave their camps in Syria escaping to Lebanon because of the bombing and the siege, confirming that Lebanese authorities still refuse to renew their residencies.

Mohammed, from the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, pointed out that when he went to the Lebanese General Security to renew his residency, the employee answered him: "there are no instructions to extend the residencies of Palestinian Syrian refugees, so I can not renew yours." The Action Group received similar complains. It is worth mentioning that the Lebanese authorities has deported 39 Palestinian refugees to Syria, as it has intensified the conditions that limits the entry of Palestinian Syrian refugees to Lebanon.

Europe

A number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Holland participated in solidarity sit-ins, held by the Palestinian community in Holland.

A solidarity sit-in was organized, today afternoon, in front of the International Court of Justice in Lahay, where the protesters raised Palestine flags and banners demanding to stop the bombing on Gaza. The protesters also chanted slogans calling for the protection of civilians in the Gaza strip from the Israeli aggression that targets civilian homes and mosques.

Sweden

One of the Sweden statistical studies pointed out that the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees who asked for asylum in Sweden countries, during the past three weeks, has reached about 490 refugees.


The study, done by the Palestinian Syrian refugee Mohammed Yousef in corporation with NJI Nyköpings Jurist & Integrations Byrå AB Company, noted that in the 24th week of 2014, from 09-06-2014 to 15-06-2014, about 120 Palestinian Syrian refugees applied asylum applications. In the 25th week of 2014, from 10-06-2014 to 16-06-2014, the number raised to 170 refugees.

The 26th week of 2014, from 23-06-2014 to 29-06-2014, the number has exceeded 200 Palestinian Syrian refugees.

It is worth mentioning that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian refugees were displaced of their camps in Syria because of the bombing and siege, as they had to flee to European beaches from Egypt and Libya by see "Death Boats" because of the mistreatment and the difficulty of staying in the neighboring countries.
