Daily report on the situation of Palestinian refugees in Syria

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"Targeting Daraa Camp and Daraa Town Neighborhood with Mortar Shells and Rockets"

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Recent Updates

Daraa camp for Palestinian refugees southern Syria was exposed to bombing with a number of mortar shells that targeted separate areas in the camp and only led to material damages. However, Daraa town and neighborhoods were exposed to rockets during the last days, where A "Fil" rocket was targeted the camp which spread panic amongst the residents and resulted in damages some houses.



It is referred that all the displaced Palestinian families from Daraa camp live now in the town area and Al Sad Road neighborhood. The refugees suffer of difficult living and security situation, where the remaining refugees of Daraa camp are suffering of dangerous humanitarian situation specially in the health and living aspects and the continuous water cut for 856 days in addition to the frequent clashes inside the camp that resulted in "according to unofficial statistics" damaging about 70% of its buildings and victims.

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On the other hand, activists and a number of the Palestinian refugees accused- the security and military institutions of the Syrian regime- of recruiting young Palestinians to their advantage in order to fight alongside the Regular Army with salaries, and the forming groups that exercised agendas that serve the interests of those institutions on the ground.

on top of those institutions come, "the Syrian Republican Guard" and "fourth band" security and military groups under the name of "national defense" and groups elaborating with Syrian Intelligence, "Palestine Branch" a, "regional branch" whereas they are targeting the rest of the Palestinian youth in Alzahera area, Jaramana Camp, Khan Danun camp, Sayeda Zainab camp, and displaced people from the Yarmouk camp, Alsbenya camp, and other camps, and also in the areas of Rural Damascus Ksahnaya and Jadedat Artoz..

An activist said, on behalf of "Walid - Abu Khaled" (a nickname), one of the Palestinian refugees who works with one of the groups of the so-called "national defense - as saying -and after being deported from the Yarmouk refugee camp, we found ourselves in a security spots that include military and security Syrian soldiers, and under security pressure and the terror of those terrorists who were saying "either with us or against us," so I had no choice but to volunteer in one of the groups, especially with the inability to leave the country" until you serve in one of the national defense.".

AGPS documented number of refugees within the –Republic Guard- who have been killed in the opposition clashes. "The Syrian Republican

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Guard" and "fourth band" both groups are elaborating with the Syrian army. In fact both groups do not include Palestinian refugees, but during the war, groups have been formed to elaborate with the Republican Guard to cover the shortfall, and to send the young Palestinians to the forefront of the fighting.

On a different context, AGPS documented the Turkish authorities different methods of treating the Palestinian-Syrian families that leaving to Europe via Turkish airports, where many cases have been delayed without giving reasons in spite of having the leaving permission -that issued by the Turkish authorities. Whereas it also documented more than three cases of those who have to pay fines —about-(\$ 1,000) per a family, while some families were prevented from entering Turkey for 5 years, in spite of having the permission to leave, some families traveled without facing any problems, despite the entry into Turkish territory without irregularly.

Many refugees confirmed to AGPS that the Turkish authorities in Ataturk and Sabeha airports were temperamental, as the officer in charge is the one who imposes fine, exemption or prohibition and fine together, without giving any explanation, where he allowed some families to leave without any problems, while he imposed fines on some families, and banned some from entering for (5) years, in spite of the similarity of the situation for those families.

The refugee, Ahmed -Nickname- told the AGPS, that his family has waited for 3 hours for the officer's permission to travel in spite of having the required from those who have (Alkimlk). Ahmed added, the officer

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asked the family to pay a fine of (\$ 1,000) before reducing it later, but he put the family names on the list of people banned from entering Turkey.

Ahmed also advised – all families that intend to follow its relatives in Europe via Turkish airports to head to the airport before (5) hours at least, and that in case of any problems with the airport authorities.

In the context, a boat carrying Syrians an Palestinians immigrants Syrians arrived to Italy, where one of the pages on the social media of Alaaden camp in Homs said that, a number of the children of the camp, set off from Egypt five days ago and arrived yesterday after great suffering on the journey, knowing that the Egyptian authorities have detained some of the Palestinian-Syrian refugees as they tried to get access to European countries through the sea.

The AGPS Monitoring and documentation team confirmed that the number of Palestinian-Syrian refugees who have taken refuge in the European Union during the period from the beginning of the year (2011) to December - (2016) has reached (79.206) refugees, according to Statistics released by the Office of the UN High Commissioner for refugees UNHCR, and the European Agency for the management of operational cooperation at the external borders of the Member States of the European Union (Frontex), and some of the statistics from the European Union and on the count of refugees to Europe.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 13\08\2016

• 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan

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- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid 2016
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1152 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1213 days, water was cut for 702 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1005 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 196 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 856 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
